

## **Visiting Instructor/Assistant Professor of Education Appointment Time Period (August-May 2018)**

The CAEP accredited School of Education at Louisiana State University in Shreveport seeks applications for a one year visiting position. This is an approved position with dedicated funding that will report to the Department Chair of Education.

### **Requirements:**

Applicants should have a Ph.D. or Ed.D. in Education or Educational Leadership or closely related area from an accredited institution. Qualified applicants must be able to teach in a 7-week, online Master of Education Leadership (MEDL) and have previous experience as a principal or superintendent in a K-12 school system. Preference will also be given to individuals who have previously taught courses in Research for School Leaders, Curriculum, or other educational leadership area. This position will also support internships in the MEDL program. While this position is expected to teach primarily graduate level courses, there may be needs at the undergraduate level as well. Remote candidates willing to teach their course load fully online will be considered.

As a fulltime visiting faculty member teaching in the School of Education, the successful candidate may be involved in ongoing program development, accreditation, public school engagement, and other professional activities.
