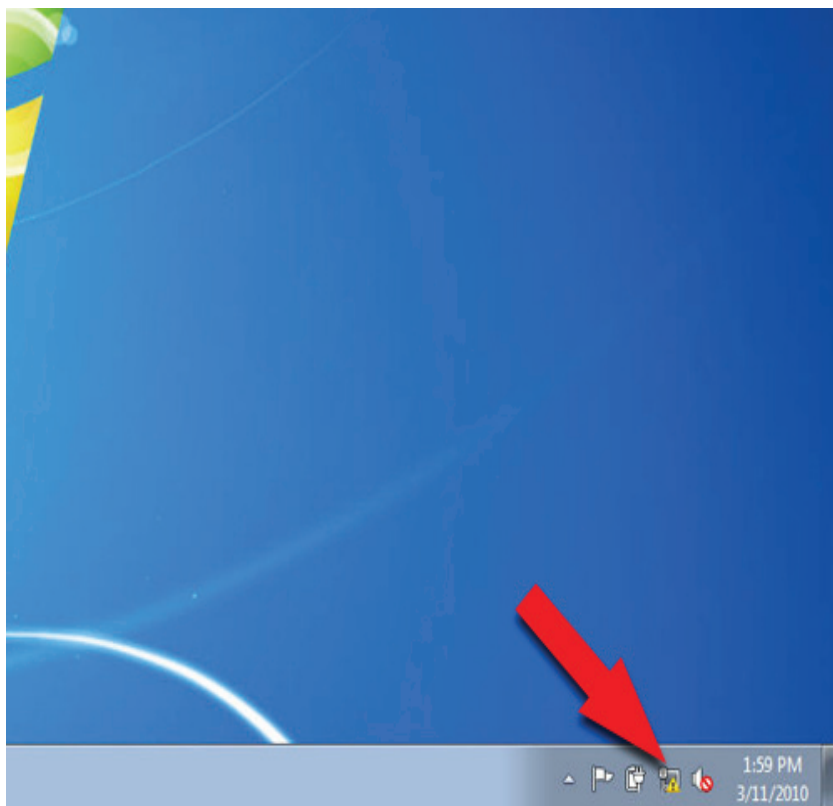


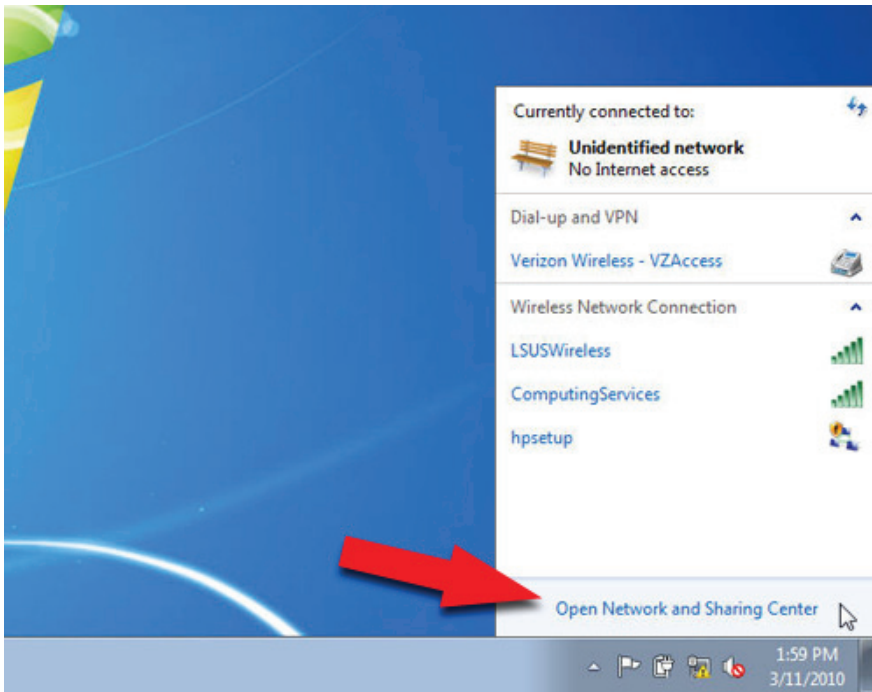
Windows 7 Wireless Guide

Before proceeding make sure you have the latest Service Packs and Windows updates installed, and also make sure your wireless adapter has the latest drivers. If your computer has a built-in wireless adapter, download the latest drivers from the computer manufacturer's website. If you have an external wireless adapter, download the latest drivers from the adapter manufacturer's website.



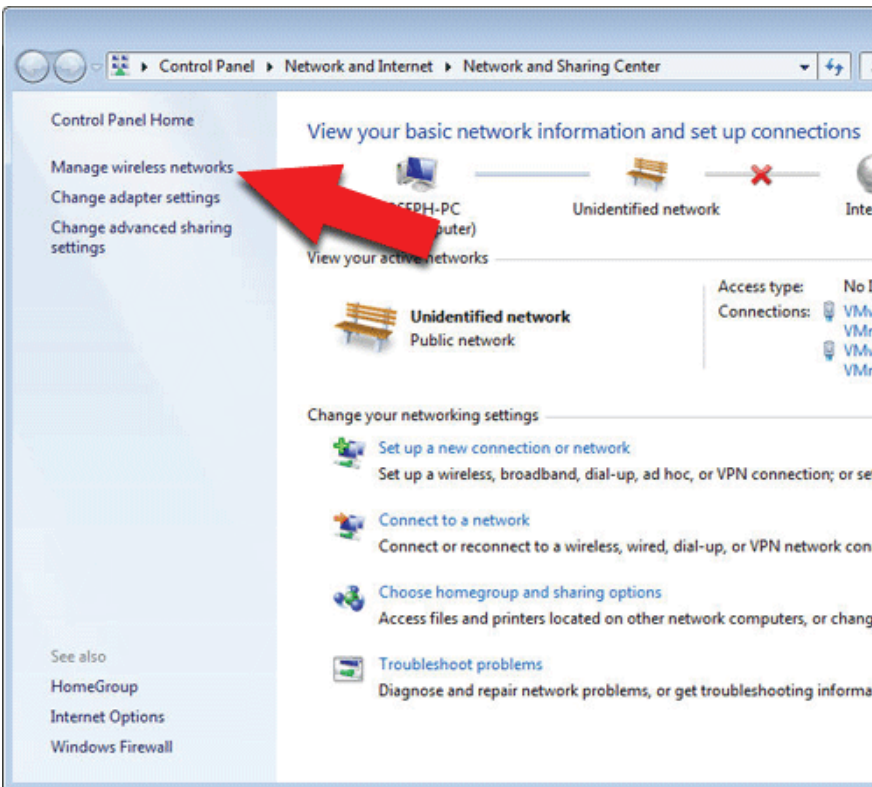
Step 1

Click the **Network and Sharing Center** Icon in the Task Tray.



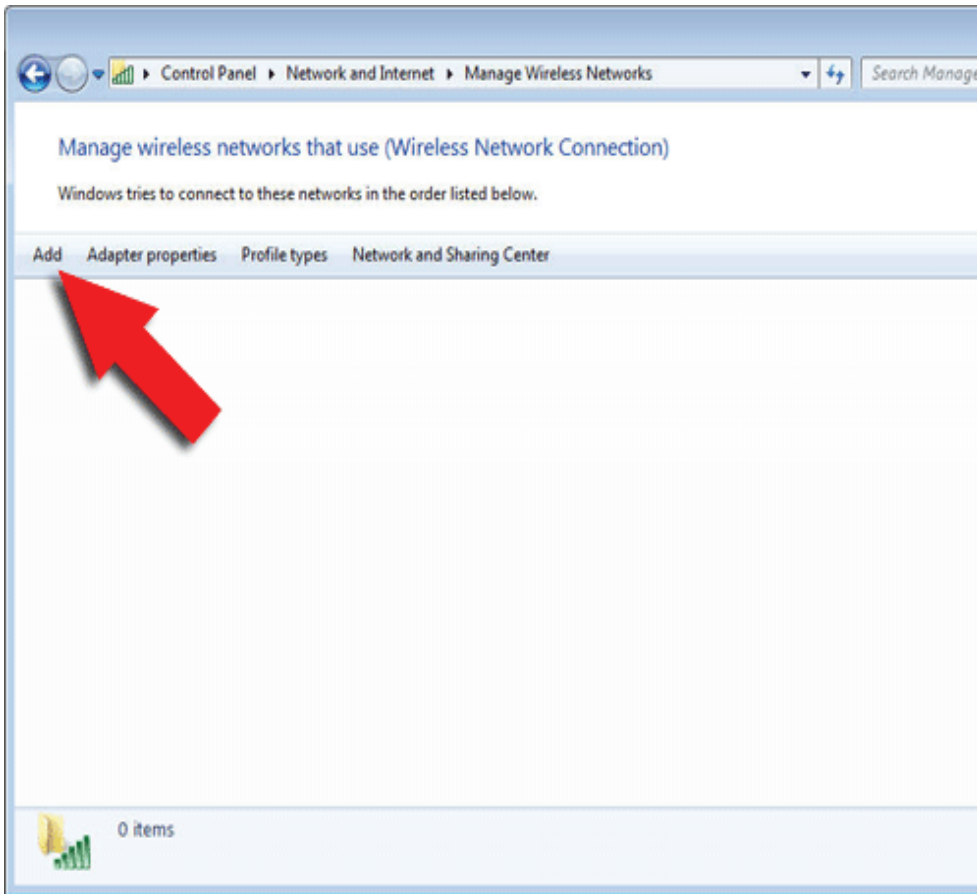
Step 2

Open Network and Sharing Center.



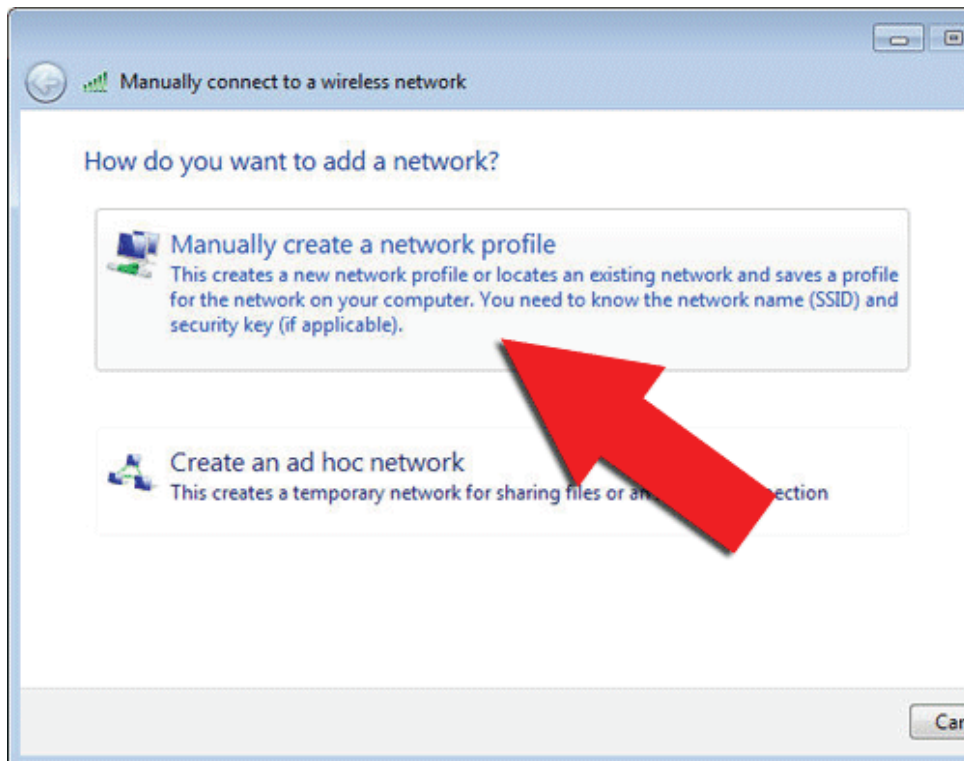
Step 3

Click Manage wireless networks.



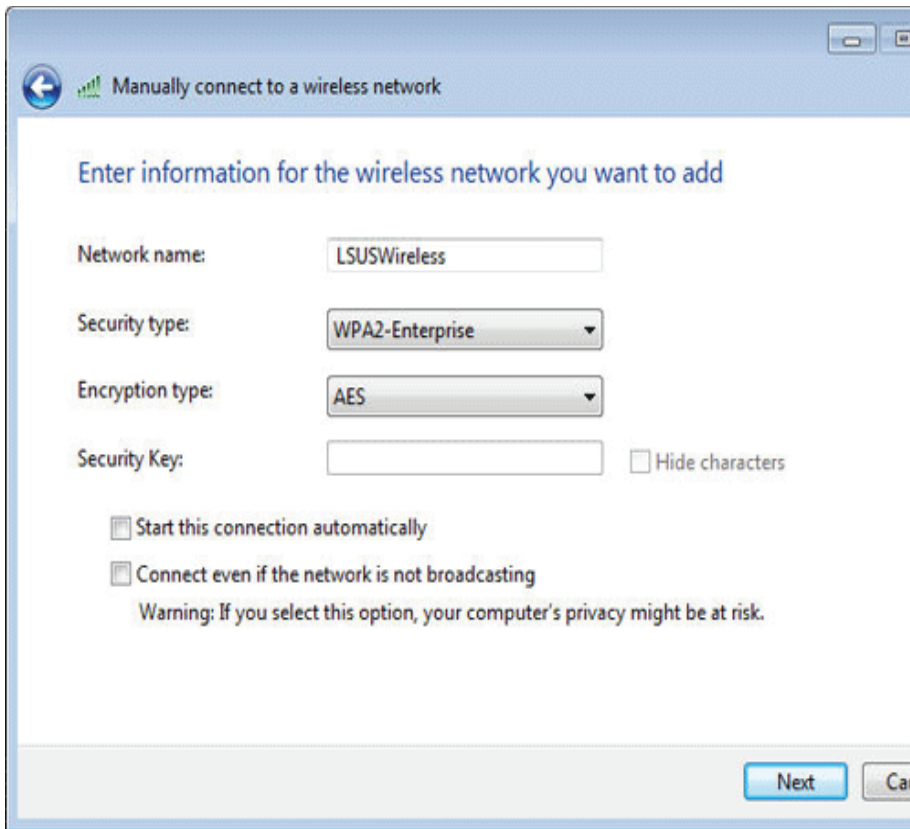
Step 4

Click **Add**.



Step 5

Click **Manually create a network profile**.

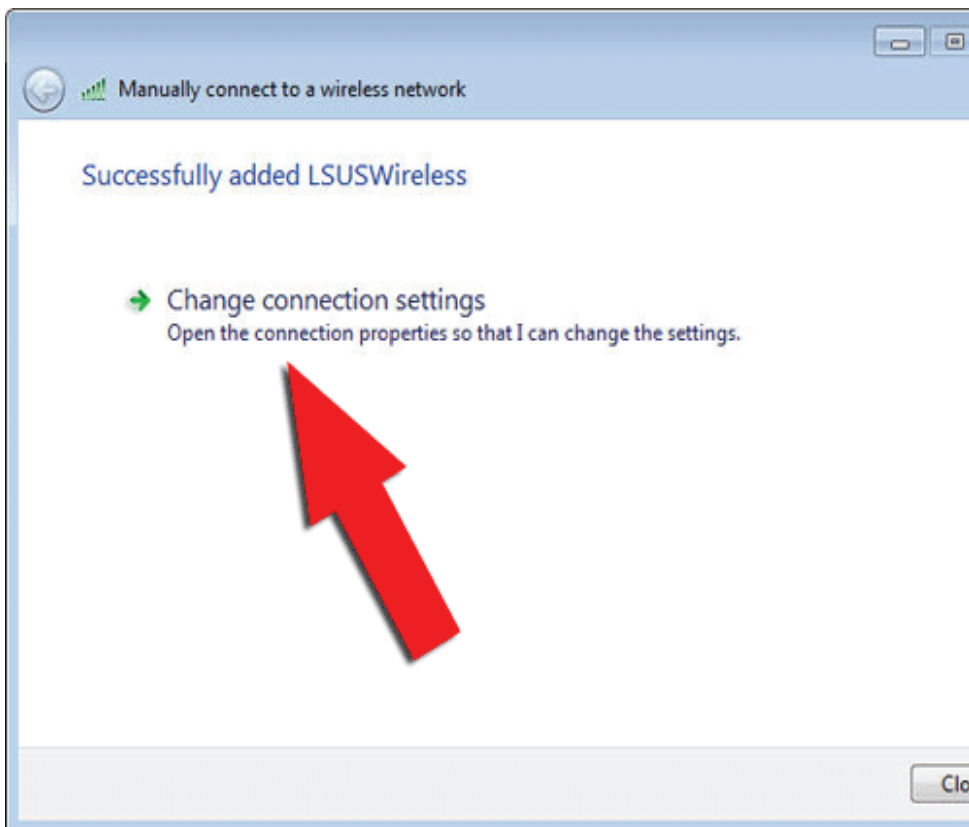


Step 6

Enter the following:

Network name: **LSUSWireless**
Security type: **WPA2-Enterprise**
Encryption type: **AES**
Security Key: **Leave Blank**
Make sure the two checkboxes are **UNCHECKED**.

Click **Next**.



Step 7

Click **Change connection settings**.



Step 8

Click the **Security** tab.

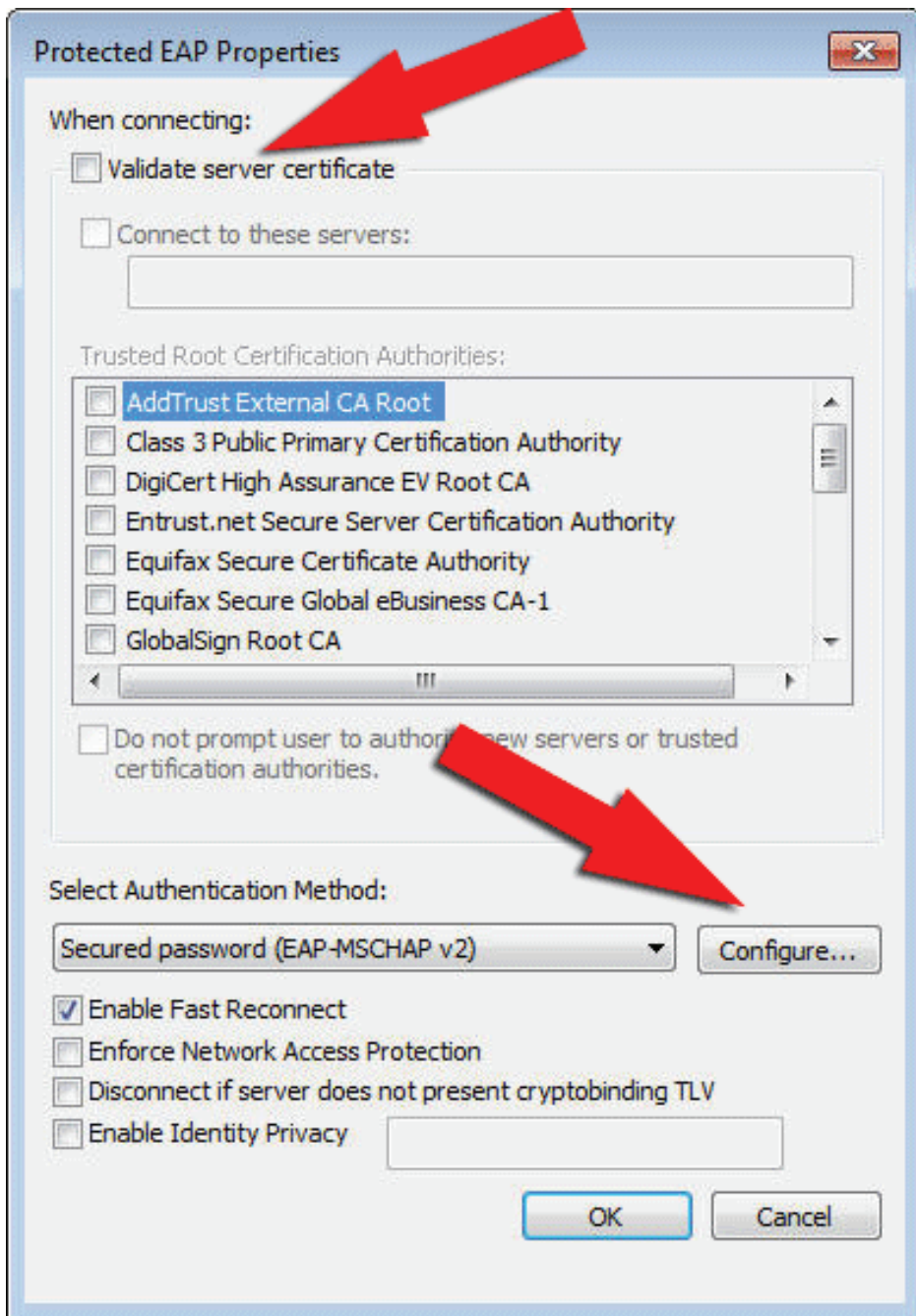
Check that Security type is **WPA2-Enterprise**.

Check that Encryption type is **AES**.

Uncheck "**Remember my credentials for this connection...**"

Check that Choose a network authentication method is set to **Microsoft: Protected EAP (PEAP)**.

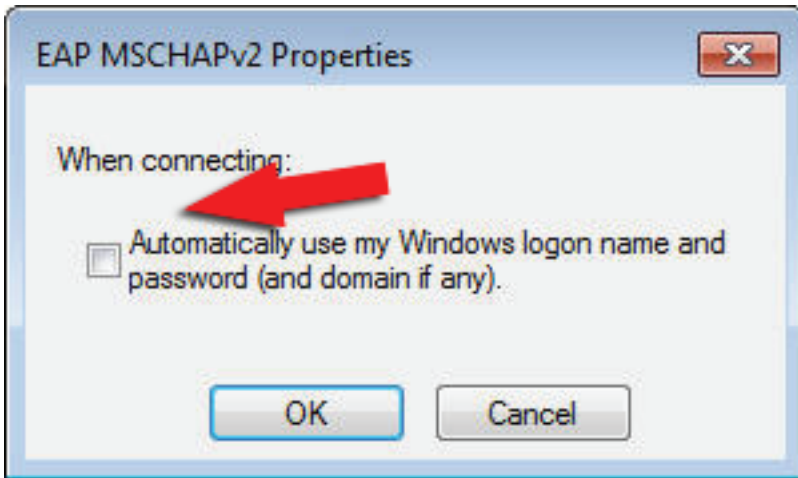
Click **Settings**



Step 9

Uncheck "**Validate server certificate**"

Click **Configure...**



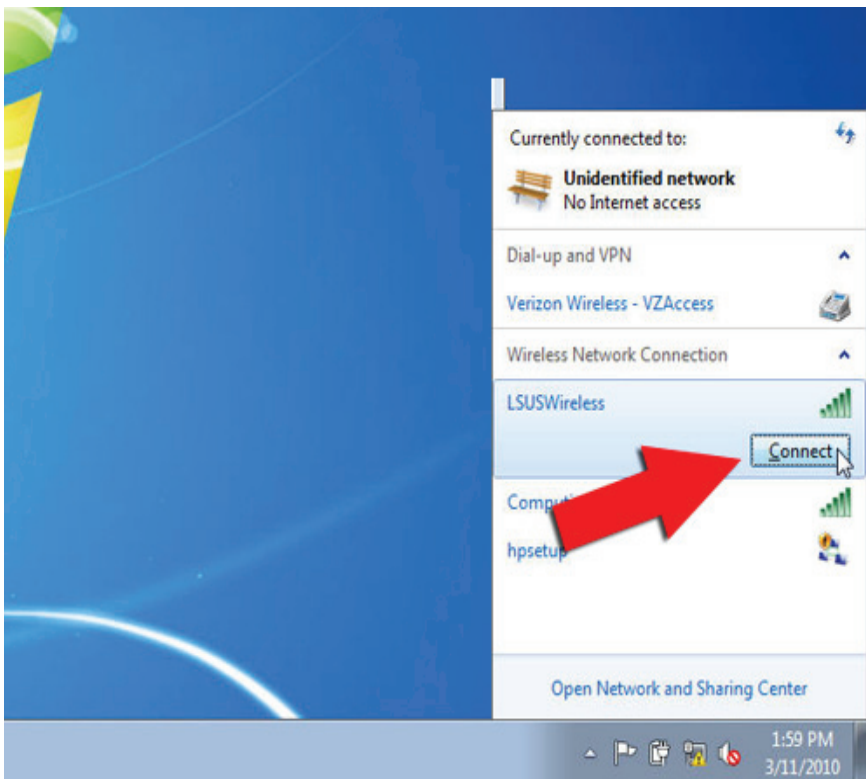
Step 10

Uncheck **Automatically use my Windows logon name...**

Click **OK**

Click **OK** on the **Protected EAP Properties Pane.**

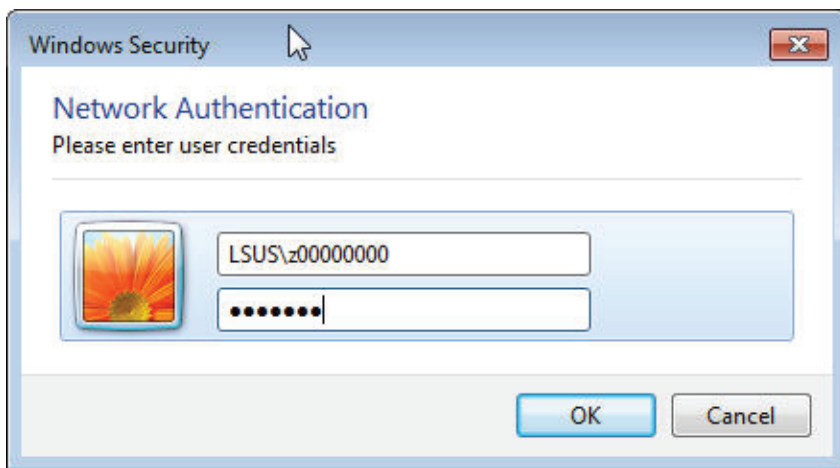
Click **OK** on the **LSUSWireless Wireless Network Properties Pane.**



Step 11

Click the **Network and Sharing Center Icon** in the Task Tray.

Click **LSUSWireless** and Click **Connect.**



Step 12

Enter **LSUS** followed by **your student or faculty id**.
Enter your **password**.
Click **OK**.
