- Announcement of student organization competition winner will be at the conclusion of the 5K.
- Organization must have a representative present in order to redeem their prize!

# **POINT BREAKDOWN**

**All organizations must submit a current roster of members and must be a 2011-12 LSUS Registered Student Organization in order to compete throughout the week.**

Your organization will receive points based on the percentage of your organization's members who **attend/participate**:

- 1) Round 'em Up Common Hour
- 2) Buck Wild Common Hour
- 3) LifeShare Blood Drive
- 4) Lady Pilots and/or Pilots Basketball Games
- 5) Overtime Party
- 6) Texas Hold 'em Casino Night
- 7) Saloon Party Common Hour
- 8) Homecoming 5K Fun Run/Walk

For these events you will receive a number of points based on the percentage of members from your organization that were in **attendance**.

Example: If 70% of the "Glee Club" shows up at Movie Night, then the "Glee Club" will receive 70 points for attending that event.

The following competitions have set points for participation from an organization, as well as 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> place.

- 9) Window Painting Contest
- 10) Canned Food Drive Contest
- 11) Photo Scavenger Hunt
- 12) Saloon Party Costume Contest

For these events, the scoring is as follows:

- 1<sup>st</sup> Place: 100 points
- 2<sup>nd</sup> Place: 75 points
- 3<sup>rd</sup> Place: 50 points
- Participation: 30 points

# WINDOW PAINTING CONTEST

## Rules

1. You must use only the paints and brushes provided (no sharpies and paint rollers). Do not stand or place paint on the picnic tables at any time while window painting. A step stool will be provided. No outside ladders will be permitted.
2. Do not paint above the blue painter's tape on your window.
3. Nothing obscene or offensive will be accepted.
4. Paint only in the area designated to your organization on the University Center windows.
5. Areas (windows) are assigned on a first come, first served basis.
6. Each student organization can only paint on **one** window. They will be numbered. If a student organization paints on more than one window, they will automatically be disqualified.
7. Window painting selection will begin at noon on Monday, February 13, 2012.
8. Painting hours will be 8 a.m. – 4 p.m. each day until it concludes on Friday at noon.
9. Do not deface or tamper with any organization's artwork at any time.
10. Windows will be judged based on the following 4 criteria:
  - a. Use of theme
  - b. Incorporating LSUS
  - c. Originality
  - d. Likeability

# CANNED FOOD DRIVE

## Rules

1. Any non-perishable food item is permitted. Donations of canned goods may be solicited from manufacturers, corporations, local stores, LSUS students and faculty, or any other reasonable source.
2. No glass containers, pet food, alcoholic beverages, or open or exposed food are allowed.
3. The last day to turn in your cans is Friday, February 17, 2012, at 12 p.m.
4. Cans must be counted prior to turning them into the UC Art Gallery.
5. Cans must be accompanied by a *Can Log Sheet*, located upstairs in the UC office.
6. Contest winners for 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, and 3<sup>rd</sup> place will be determined by the maximum amount of cans that are donated by each organization.
7. All cans will be donated to the Food Bank of Northwest Louisiana.

# **WILD, WILD PHOTO SCAVENGER HUNT**

## **Rules**

1. Each team must be comprised of exactly three people. All participants must be current LSU students with a valid Pilot Card. One person must be selected as the team captain because this person will be responsible for taking pictures. Teams must provide their own digital camera (phones are acceptable).
2. Packets for the hunt may be picked-up in the University Center Office at 3:30 p.m. Teams may still pick-up packets after that time but they will not receive extended time for being late. All packets are due promptly at 5:45 p.m., upstairs in the UC office.
3. Each team will be given brief instructions before they begin the event, which will also be included in the packet along with the clues. Each photo taken in the correct location with all team members will be worth a set amount of points. The team captain will always photograph the other members at each stop. In the event of a tie, the team that submitted its packet first will win the tiebreaker.
4. Each clue will describe a person, place, or thing as it relates to the homecoming theme. The clue may require that you go off campus so teams must provide their own transportation. Please make sure that each driver and vehicle is in compliance with all state laws.
5. Each team will be assigned an event official that pictures may be sent to by phone and email. Teams may also choose to upload pictures to a jump drive and submit that. Every team must return to the UC Office, even if all pictures have been sent. Time will stop for a team upon arrival in the office.

## **Rules**

1. Participants must provide a valid student ID to be eligible for the \$5.00 registration fee. Participants who pre-register will be guaranteed a t-shirt. You may register in the Rec Sports Office or on-line at [www.sportspectrumusa.com](http://www.sportspectrumusa.com), in person at Sportspectrum on Fern Avenue, or until 8 a.m. race morning at the race site.
2. Please wear appropriate clothing and footwear to participate.
3. Race will begin at 8:30 a.m. in the area between the HPE Building and Intramural Fields.
4. When checking in for the race, make sure to sign-in for the student organization.
5. Waffles will be served after the 5K. There will be a \$5 fee for non-participants who would like waffles.
