1) Choose from GEOG 105, 106, 251, 252; POLI 101, 151, 256; PSYC 152, 206; SOCL 105, 107, 142. 2) Choose from ENGL 205, 210, 215, 220, 301; FREN 201, 205; HIST 105, 106, 107, 145, 146; MCOM 115, SPAN 201, 205, PHIL105 or 250. 3) Must take 3 hours from BIOS and 3 hours from CHEM, PHYS, ASTR OR PHSC. The remaining 3 hours need to complete a 2-term sequence in BIOS or the other area they chose. Approved sequences include: BIOS 101/10\_ or BIOS 110/120; ASTR 105/106; CHEM 121/124; PHSC 105/106; OR PHYS 261/262. 4) Choose from COMM 260, 261; FA 100, 140, 221, 240, 241; MUS 120, 260; HPE 112, 125 or 141. HPE courses are 1 hour each, so three classes must be taken to meet the 3-hour credit requirement. 5) FS 100+ is required for all first-time freshmen and all transfer students with fewer than 30 total semester hours of credit. Approved courses include FS 101, 102, 103, or 104. Students with more than 30 hours may take an approved elective instead. 6) Students pursuing two accounting courses should take ACCT 309 and one of the following: ACCT 310, ACCT 320, ACCT 330 and ACCT 460. Students pursuing two marketing courses should take at least one of the following: MKT 310, 312, 330, 401, or 445. In addition, ECON 310 may count as one of the two required courses in the Finance area of study. All major electives must be 300/400 level. ACCT/FIN/MADM/MKT 475 can be used as an elective in your major only once. 7) Other CBA electives may be any 100+ course in the CBA. Common choices for CBA electives include: MADM 105/205, UNIV 200, FIN 231, INDS 101, LDSH 201or 202. **GPA Requirements:** Students must have a GPA of 2.0 or greater in the following areas in order to graduate: Overall, LSUS, CBA core, major courses and CBA courses. Students must make a C or better in their major courses and MADM 480. ★Must have 6 hours of international content. Choose from: any foreign language; ANTH 210; BLAW 420; ECON 460; FIN 440; GEOG 105, 106, 252, 410, 453, 460; HIST 251, 252, 386; INDS 101; INTL 250; MADM 360, 423, 430; MKT 440; POLI 203, 204, 425, 460; UNIV 299.
