Health and Physical Education--Exercise Science and Wellness Concentration: Students choosing to concentrate in Exercise Science and Wellness should follow the curriculum listed above for the freshmen year except for the KHS courses. Simultaneously, they should meet with an advisor in the Department of Kinesiology and Health Science to plan a curriculum. This is a concentration which, after completion of the requirements for the Physical Therapy Assistant program at Bossier Parish Community College, can be transferred to LSUS as part of the requirements for concentration. Students can transfer no more than ½ of the required hours from a 2-year college to LSUS. Students wishing to pursue this option should meet with the Chair of Kinesiology and Health Science.
