

Pre-Pharmacy

LSUS offers course work to prepare a student to apply for admission to the College of Pharmacy and Health Sciences, University of Louisiana at Monroe or to the College of Pharmacy, Xavier University in New Orleans. Approximately two years of college work in specified areas is required to be eligible for admission to either program. A student interested in pharmacy should consult with an adviser from the College of Sciences during his or her first term at LSUS. This Pre-Pharmacy curriculum is intended only as a guide. The general catalog of the university from which the student intends to graduate should also be consulted to plan the two-year program at LSUS.
