

## English

The student majoring in English must take at least 42 hours above freshman English, with at least 30 of those hours in courses numbered 300 and above. The student must also complete 12 hours of one foreign language, consisting of 101, 102, 201, and any other course numbered 205 and above. In addition, the student must take six hours in courses numbered 300 and above offered by other departments, as well as a course in oral communications.
