1. In order to be admitted to TEPAR: Teacher Education Program Admission and Retention and to take 300 and 400 level courses in Education, the following criteria must be met:
 - a. Admission to LSU-S
 - b. Completion of COMM 135, ENG 105 and 115 with grades of "C" or better.
 - c. Overall GPA of 2.5
 - d. Completion of 45 semester hours
 - e. Submission of passing scores from the PRAXIS I-Pre Professional Skills Tests in reading, writing, and mathematics.

2. Completion of all materials and methods courses is required prior to enrollment in Student Teaching

3. It is the responsibility of the student to report to the Office of the Dean of the College of Education (BE 117) at least three weeks prior to the conclusion of the final semester of the program to initiate the certification application process.

Admission to the Program by application through the Teacher Education Program Admission and Retention (TEPAR) Committee is required prior to enrollment in any 300 or 400 level course in Education or Kinesiology and Health Science. Application forms may be obtained in the Curriculum Resource Center (BE 213). The **Principles of Learning and Teaching, grades K -6 (#30522) and Elementary Education Content Knowledge (#10014)** Praxis exams must be successfully completed prior to application for certification.
