SUBJECT: SMOKING

I. PURPOSE

This policy is designed to provide the best possible health environment for students, faculty and staff and to protect the rights of individuals.

II. GENERAL POLICY

- A. Smoking is prohibited in all university buildings.
- B. The use of smokeless tobacco products is prohibited in all university buildings.
- C. Smoking is permitted outside of the buildings but no smoking is allowed within 25 feet of a building entrance.
- D. "Thank You For Not Smoking and/or Using Smokeless Tobacco" signs will be posted on campus as needed.
