Subject: QEP options results
The votes are in!

After throwing out a few responses that didn't rank the three (they simply chose one), I ended up with 101 responses. For our own information, can someone determine what percentage that represents?

Here are the results of the tally, in which the first choice is given 3 points, second choice 2 points, and third choice 1 point:

B -- 236
A -- 201
C -- 169

With this type of ranking, it's also important to look at the number of people who select each choice, and to compare how frequently each option is preferred over each of the other options. Here's the breakdown of first choices:

52 people chose B as their first choice,
38 people chose A,
11 people chose C.

So we actually have a majority of people preferring one over the others. In addition, we can look at the least preferred choice. Option C was ranked third by 44 people. Clearly, we can conclude that option C is not favored.

When we compare A with B, we find that of the 101 who responded, 59 ranked B higher than A.

We can conclude that option B (INCREASING THE QUANTITY AND QUALITY OF PERSONAL ATTENTION GIVEN TO STUDENTS) is the one preferred by the campus community.
