Credit may be earned through the American College Testing Program (ACT), the College Entrance Examination Board Tests from Educational Testing Service (ETS), the College Level Examination Program (CLEP)--subject or general, and LSUS Departmental Examination. Credit for formal military service-school courses is determined in accordance with the recommendations of the American Council on Education (ACE) published in the Guide to the Evaluation of Educational Experiences in the Armed Services.
