**A Proposal to Make Recommendations to Amend the *Student Conduct Code* in Order to
Change the Makeup of the Student Conduct Board and to Change the Definition of
Quorum**

BE IT KNOWN THAT, pursuant to the provisions of Section 4.1.1 of the *Student Conduct Code*, the LSUS Student Conduct Board is composed of five (5) faculty members, one from each College of the University and one from the library, and two (2) student representatives, and that quorum for the LSUS Student Conduct Board is defined as five (5) members being present without specifying that any student members must be present.

WHEREAS, student members not being present at Student Conduct Board meetings lends a perception of unfairness to the hearing from the perspective of the student.

WHEREAS, the current number of student representatives on the Student Conduct Board increases the likelihood that meetings could take place without having a student representative present.

WHEREAS, the Student Affairs Committee is the administrative body at this University vested with the authority to amend the *Student Conduct Code* subject to the approval of the Faculty Senate.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Student Government Association should pass this Bill in its entirety, and by doing so, sending a recommendation to the Student Affairs Committee and the Faculty Senate of the University that Section 4.1.1 of the *Student Conduct Code* should be amended so that there shall be four (4) student representatives on the Student Conduct Board, one from each College of the University and so that quorum shall be redefined as five (5) members being present, with at least one more faculty member than students present. The SGA should further recommend that these changes shall not go into effect until the 2006-2007 school year.
