The LSUS SGA Constitution makes clear the belief that the SGA has a right to "participate in a significant manner in the operations of our University"; and,

Whereas,

Many students have voiced concern that they are unable to forward their student email; and,

Whereas,

Students of LSUS look to the SGA for answers about changes in policy at the University; and,

Whereas,

The LSUS SGA, and the students of LSUS, feel they deserve, and demand, an authoritative response to the reasoning behind this change.

That the Student Senate of Louisiana State University at Shreveport vote to direct the SGA President to work with the SGA faculty advisor to research, locate, and formally invite the head of the Computing Services department to a question and answer session with the full Student Senate regarding the lack of email forwarding for students on campus.
