Incentive for Student Interest, Satisfaction, and Involvement (ISISI) Act

Be it known,

The Louisiana State University at Shreveport Student Government Association shall create an incentive for students to create interest, satisfaction, and involvement once a month at Student Senate meetings by appropriating a pizza fund.

Whereas,

Student involvement in weekly Student Senate meetings has been nonexistent or marginal for the last several months; and,

Whereas,

The SGA serves the students and having student participation would benefit the Student Senate and allow the Student Senate the better serve the SGA; and,

Whereas,

The Constitution declares it is the Senate's duty "to draft and/or enact resolutions, monetary appropriations, and recommendations deemed necessary to serve the SGA"; and,

Whereas,

The Constitution declares it within the powers of the Senate "To make appropriations from the SGA budget for student activities"; and,

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED: That the Student Senate of Louisiana State University in Shreveport creates a \$60 a month pizza fund, appropriated from the SGA budget, to be managed by the SGA Vice-President. The Vice-President will be tasked with ordering, picking up, and setting up pizzas and drinks for the first scheduled Student Senate meeting of each month, beginning with March 1, 2007.

THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: The Public Relations Committee will be tasked with creating sufficient publicity for each of these monthly events.

ELASTIC CLAUSE: If, after two of these special pizza meetings, the increase in student involvement is deemed insignificant by the Senate, this act will become null and void and the pizza fund will be taken out of the budget appropriation.
