Student Accessibility and Mobility Extension (SAME) Act

Be it known,

The Louisiana State University at Shreveport Student Government Association shall direct the SGA President to meet with responsible parties involved in the west side doors of the Technology Center being locked during school hours and either get them unlocked or have said parties present a valid explanation in front of the Student Senate.

Whereas,

The doors on the west side of the Technology Center are locked from the outside at all hours and this provides considerable inconvenience for students wishing to enter this building; and,

Whereas,

The SGA was presented with a formal petition from students and faculty addressing their desire to have these west side doors unlocked from the outside during university hours; and,

Whereas,

According to the SGA Constitution Article IV, Section 5, Subsection i it is the duty of the Student Senate "To act on all matters referred to by petition from the Student Body."

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED: That the Student Senate of Louisiana State University in Shreveport directs the SGA President to find out the responsible parties for having these doors locked and meet with them. The President will then either convince them to unlock the doors from the outside during school hours or have said parties present before the Senate a valid explanation of why these doors must be locked. This must be done and presented on the March 8, 2007 Student Senate meeting.
