The Website Advancement for SGA Promotion (WASP) Act

Be it known,

The Louisiana State University at Shreveport Student Government Association shall better inform its members on its actions and status with a new website. This new website will be updated in a timely manner after each meeting. A link to this website will appear on the main page of the LSUS website.

Whereas,

The LSUS SGA currently has a website that is rarely updated, extremely outdated, and difficult to navigate; and,

Whereas,

The LSUS SGA website is uninviting, aesthetically displeasing, and unsightly; and,

Whereas,

When the Executive Board members currently submit update information to the website it is either not updated or updated several months later; and,

Whereas,

Many students have voiced concern that the SGA website has a deficit of current information, navigability, and style; and,



Whereas,

The Constitution declares it is the Senate's duty "to draft and/or enact resolutions...and recommendations deemed necessary to serve the SGA."

Whereas,

LSUS recently hired a new webmaster that just made a faculty senate website who has stated that he will create a site for the SGA and that he will update it quickly after receiving update information.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED: That the Student Senate of Louisiana State University in Shreveport directs the President to gain approval from University Center Director Joseph Pearson for a new website to be created by Tom Barnes. The President will then convey this approval to Tom Barnes.

THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: That the Senate directs the Secretary and President Pro-Temp to meet with Tom Barnes before March 1. The Secretary will present him with all information relating to SGA bios, legislation, meeting minutes, a fully current and updated version of the constitution and bylaws, and upcoming agenda. The President Pro-Temp will be tasked with approving the site's design.

THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: The Senate requests that a link to this new site be placed on the main LSUS front page in the Current Students section next to Campus Life.

THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: Beginning with the website's creation, the Secretary will be tasked with providing Mr. Barnes with all Senate updates, including legislation, minutes, fully updated and current copies of the constitution and bylaws, and upcoming agendas by the Wednesday before each meeting.
