A MOC Act (President Pro-Tempore Joseph Hayes) - President Pro-Tempore Joseph Hayes reads proposed legislation. Vice President Paschal opens the floor for discussion. Senator Nicole Goad motions to limit debate to 10 minutes. Senator Mikea Scott seconds the motion. All senators vote in favor of limiting debate to 10 minutes. President Pro-Tempore Joseph Hayes motions to suspend Robert's Rules of Order. Senator Alisha Howard seconds the motion. All senators vote in favor of suspending Robert's Rules of Order and taking a vote. Senator Nicole Goad motions to vote. Senator Mikea Scott seconds the motion. All senators vote in favor of the legislation. The MOC Act passes.

B EEC Act (President Pro-Tempore Joseph Hayes) - President Pro-Tempore Joseph Hayes reads proposed legislation. Vice President Paschal opens the floor for discussion. President Pro-Tempore Joseph Hayes motions to suspend Robert's Rules of Order. Senator Alisha Howard seconds the motion. All senators vote in favor of suspending Robert's Rules of Order and taking a vote. Senator Nicole Goad motions to vote. Senator Matthew Baker seconds the motion. All senators vote in favor of the legislation. The EEC Act passes.

C SIFF Act (President Pro-Tempore Joseph Hayes) - President Pro-Tempore Joseph Hayes reads proposed legislation. Vice President Paschal opens the floor for discussion. UC Director Joseph Pearson states that a letter from the Chancellor, Vincent Marsala, was distributed based on a recommendation that the chancellor form a committee for feasibility of the proposed project. The committee's recommendation was to hire consultants to form a feasibility study. The consultants then talked with groups from all over campus. Additionally, a survey was conducted of the student body. February 1-2, 2007 the consultants will be on campus. They will give a report and address all questions in the survey and thereafter provide a recommendation regarding the feasibility of the Rec Center. Pearson invites SGA to attend and will request that they provide a copy of the survey results. Senator Nicole Goad motions to amend the bill to state the following: " (a)consultants provide senate copies of final report no later than the February 1-2, 2007 meeting (b) an executive member attends (c)the executive member provides a report to the senate thereafter." Senator Badreka Harper seconds the motion. All senators vote in favor of the proposed amendment. The

amendment passes. Senator Nicole Goad motions to suspend Robert's Rules of Order. Senator Alisha Howard seconds the motion. All senators vote in favor of suspending Robert's Rules of Order and taking a vote. Senator Nicole Goad motions to vote. Senator Alisha Howard seconds the motion. All senators vote in favor of the legislation. The SIFF Act passes.
