**II Approval of Minutes**

- ii. Student Ids/ Bookstore Policy - President Dennis yields the floor to Robert Lewis, Director of the University Bookstore. Robert Lewis provides the following as justifications for requiring student identification for bookstore purchases:
  - The bookstore does not have an alpha keyboard to type in the new student identifications numbers
  - Information from the student identification cards are used to collect debts for checks
  - Allows for the use of 3<sup>rd</sup> party checks
  - Serves as authorization for the Louisiana auditors requirement in tracking all textbook returns
  - Bookstore can provide courtesy call to students if classes are cancelled
  - IDs are not needed for cash purchases
  - Alerts bookstore to purchase additional books if non LSUS students purchase textbooks (LSUS has on of the lowest margins on textbooks in the state)
- iii. E-mail Forwarding - President Dennis yields the floor to Dr. Gloria
