II Approval of Minutes

Senator Mikea Scott motions to approve the minutes. Senator Daniel Antle seconds the motion. President Pro-Tempore Joseph Hayes abstains and all other senators vote in favor of approving the meeting minutes.

President Pro-Tempore Joseph Hayes requests that the agenda be amended to include his executive report. Senator Matthew Baker motions to include a report from President Pro-Tempore Joseph Hayes. Senator Nicole Goad seconds the motion. All senators vote in favor of amending the meeting agenda.

III Executive Reports

- A President Denitra Dennis has nothing to report.
- B Vice-President Shay Paschal has nothing to report.
- C Executive Secretary Ebonee Rhodes has nothing to report.
- D President Pro-Tempore Joseph Hayes requests an update on the scantron legislation. President Denitra Dennis reports that scantrons have been purchased and are now available to students. President Pro-Tempore Hayes also reports that he will provide copies of the election rules. Senator Nicole Goad expresses concern about an email that she received regarding the Public Relations committee. She requests a deadline extension should be extended. Senator Goad reports that intent to run flyers will be ready for review by the Executive on Tuesday.

IV Special Guest Speakers

- A Rebecca Chiles, Director of the University Police - President Dennis

requests that an explanation be provided as to why the doors in the Technology Center are locked.

Rebecca Chiles reports that the doors to the Technology Center will remain unlocked, facility services will place glass on the doors for security issues, and all concerns have been addressed with those who occupy office spaces in this building.

V Committee Reports

A Student Affairs - Senator Mikea Scott reports that this committee was unable to meet.

B Professor of the Year- Senator Mikea Scott reports that the theme will be blue and gold. Table designs and decorations were also discussed. The next meeting will be held March 6th at 2pm in the Pilot's Room.

VI Old Business

A CHIC Act (President Pro-Tempore Joseph Hayes) – This bill shows the senate's support for re-establishing email forwarding. Senator Nicole Goad motions to vote. Senator Mikea Scott seconds the motion. All senators vote in favor of the CHIC Act. The CHIC Act passes.

VII New Business

A New Senatorial Appointment- Steven Williams – Steven Williams addresses the senate with reasons for wanting to join Student Government. No discussion takes place. Senator Nicole Goad motions to vote. Senator Mikea Scott seconds the motion. All senators vote in favor of appointing Steven Williams as senator –at-large.

B Incentive for Student Interest, Satisfaction, and Involvement Act (Senator Matthew Baker) – This bill creates a \$60 a month pizza fund to increase student involvement in weekly Student Senate meetings. Executive Secretary Rhodes states that she has organized the last two SGA days and there was not a significant increase in participation or membership. UC Director Joseph Pearson states that hosting this event during common hour limits involvement due to competition with other organizations. He also adds that change in class scheduling is fundamental. President Pro-Tempore Joseph Hayes recommends purchasing a few pizzas and changing the time and venue for this event.

Senator Daniel Antle recommends that the Public Relations Committee increase their advertising efforts.
C Student Accessibility and Mobility Extension Act (Senator Matthew

Baker) – The author removes this legislation.

D The Website Advancement for SGA Promotion (Senator Matthew Baker & President Pro-Tempore Joseph Hayes) – President Dennis reports that SGA is scheduled to have a new website by this summer and the webmaster may take longer. She also cautions that more organizations will have website requests for the webmaster.

President Pro-Tempore Joseph Hayes reports that the same template will be used as for the faculty senate website. He also states that updates for SGA should be placed at the top of the agenda, webmaster.

UC Director Joseph Pearson states that he will discuss this issue with Tom Barnes.

President Dennis states that in order to allow proper time for the agenda to appear on the website, legislation is due Tuesday before the week of the meeting you would like it to appear.
