(3) President Pro-Tempore Joseph Hayes motions remove previous amendment to eliminate payment needed by students for those who can prove they are in night class. Senator Nicole Goad seconds. Senator Matthew Baker votes in opposition and all other senators vote in favor of removing the amendment. The motion passes.
- Senator Nicole Goad motions to vote on the bill. Senator Alisha Howard seconds. Senator Matthew Baker votes in opposition of bill and all other senators vote in favor of the bill. The bill passes.

VI New Business

- A Senatorial Appointment of Brandon Johnson - Brandon Johnson states that he wants to help the student body by improving student life and continuing to build the campus. Vice President Paschal opens the floor for discussion. No discussion is needed. President Pro-Tempore Joseph Hayes motions to vote for the senatorial appointment. Senator Daniel Antle seconds the motion. All vote in favor of appointing Brandon Johnson to the College of Liberal Arts.
- B Parliamentary Reference Update Amendment (Nicole Goad) - Senator Nicole Goad amends her amendment to include "and current editions." Senator Shay Paschal opens the floor for discussion. Discussion takes place concerning new changes to Robert's Rules. Senator Nicole Goad motions to suspend Robert Rules of order and vote on the amendment. President Pro-Tempore Joseph Hayes seconds. All senators vote in favor of suspending

Robert's Rules and taking a vote. President Pro-Tempore Joseph Hayes motions to vote. Senator Nicole Goad seconds the motion. All vote in favor of the amendment.
