## • Career Opportunity Listing

You may list career opportunities, internships, full-time and part-time jobs, volunteer opportunities and summer camp work through Career Pilot. You may also fax, mail, or email current or future career opportunities available in your company.

## • On-Campus Interviews

Professional on-campus interview facilities are provided in our office on a complimentary basis.

## • Information Sessions

Meet students in a less formal environment. Hold an information session at a convenient location on campus the evening before interviews or several weeks prior to interviews. Bring LSUS alumni who work for you!

## • Employer Literature

Your employer information displayed in our Career Resources Library and Lab keeps your name in front of LSUS students year round. Provide binders with testimonials from LSUS alumni who work for your organization. Brochures and other informational flyers are also helpful tools.

## • Campus Advertising

Advertise your campus activities or employment opportunities in the student newspaper, *The Almagest*. It is distributed weekly throughout the campus during the academic year. Send your employer flyers and posters to us so we may post in student areas such as the University Center and academic buildings.

## • Practice Interviews

Participate for a full day or half day in our Practice Interview opportunities for LSUS students. A Practice Interview is a very valuable career tool for students and an opportunity for you to increase your organization's visibility on our campus.

## • Career Workshops

You are invited to conduct career workshops that are open to all LSUS students and alumni. Examples of past workshops include: *First Day on the Job*, *The Successful Candidate*, *Resumes That Work* or *Buzz Words for Our Industry*. Workshops provide students with a unique view of the professional world and provide you with another opportunity to increase your visibility.

## • Faculty Luncheons and Classroom Interaction

You may host a faculty luncheon or participate in classroom discussions. Your professional perspective reinforces the academic environment and increases your visibility with students and those who influence them.

## • Career Fairs

The Career Services Office presents two employer recruiting events (Fall Career Fair and Spring Employer Expo) each academic year that are open to all students and all majors.
