Completer Satisfaction Survey - Fall 2021 & Spring 2022

The EPP administered the Completer Satisfaction survey to 12 graduates from Fall 2020. This data are reflected in the Fall 2021 data collection cycle. The Spring 2022 data collection cycle included 16 graduates from Spring 2021.

For Fall 2020 graduates, all 13 components were identified as strengths. For Spring 2021 graduates, areas of strength were identified as teaching content area(s), using varied instructional approaches, managing classroom dynamics, being a reflective practitioner, working with diverse populations, collaborating with families, using technology to facilitate instruction, and the year-long residency preparation for 1st year teaching. For Fall 2020 graduates, no areas of refinement were identified. For Spring 2021 graduates, areas of refinement includes managing classroom dynamics and working with EL Learners.
