Louisiana State University System Application for Resident Classification Louisiana State University - Shreveport

The application shall include any information or documents required by the University, together with supporting evidence which the student desires to submit. Failure to comply timely with the appeals procedure shall constitute a waiver of all claims for reclassification for the applicable term or semester.

A resident for tuition purposes is one who has abandoned all prior domiciles and has been domiciled in the State of Louisiana continuously for at least one full year (365 days) immediately preceding the first day of classes of the term for which resident classification is sought. Physical presence of the applicant must be associated with substantial evidence that such presence was with the intent to maintain a Louisiana domicile. Physical presence within the state solely for educational purposes without substantial evidence of the intent to remain in Louisiana will not be sufficient evidence for resident classification regardless of the length of time within the state.

Suggested Items to Accompany Application for Resident Classification

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- A copy of your lease or deed to the property. If neither a lease nor a deed is available, provide a statement from the owner of property indicating the terms of your occupancy including the date when it actually began.
- 6 A copy of your Alien Registration card (green card).
- 7 A copy of your driver's license and/or vehicle registration.
- 8 A copy of your voter registration.
- Copies of the following to verify the date you first became a resident of Louisiana: lease or deed, utility receipts, statements from organizations you belong to that can verify your residency; verification of your Louisiana residency from a bank or credit union.
- A letter of verification sent directly to the Admissions Office- Attn: Director of Admissions from each employer for the past year.
 - If yes, provide a copy of the last two returns (Federal and State). If no, and you are under the age of 24, provide a copy of your parent(s) returns or a statement that you have not been claimed on the returns of your parent(s).
 - 14 If yes, provide copies of the last two returns.
 - 17 Sign and date your statement.
 - Copies of Louisiana Tax Returns are available from the Department of Revenue & Taxation, Income Tax Division, 330 N. Ardenwood, Baton Rouge, LA 70821 (phone, 225-925-4611). You may request the returns be sent to the Director of Admissions, or you may send them with your application.
 - If you have ever been classified as a resident for tuition purposes at an LSU campus, please request the Office of the Registrar at that campus to provide a statement to that effect. You may provide that statement with your application or have it sent directly to the Director of Admissions.
