CAREER FAIRS

Each semester, employers participate in a campus-wide event to connect with prospective intern and job candidates. Undergraduate students, graduate students, and alumni from all majors are invited to explore opportunities and develop authentic connections with alumni, employers, and graduate/professional school representatives.

HANDSHAKE

Handshake is the university's centralized job posting site. With this system, our employer partners post part-time work, internships, and full-time positions. Navigate to lsus.joinhandshake.com and enter your LSUS email address to activate your account.

ON-CAMPUS INTERVIEWS (OCIs)

Some employers visit campus to conduct in-person interviews for their internship and full-time opportunities. OCIs run through Handshake; it is the system where you will find the positions and where you can submit your application materials. The platform also enables applicants to select their interview time.

INFORMATION SESSIONS
