- What is distinctive about this role at LSUS?
- What challenges are on the horizon in the next one to five years that will require this person's leadership, energy, and effort? How will the unit need to evolve to address those challenges?
- What are the specific opportunities for impact in this role? What would make this an exciting and compelling leadership position for an outstanding candidate?
- What kinds of candidate profiles do you hope to see in the pool and what technical skills are must-haves versus good-to-haves?

5. Brainstorming about Potential Candidates and Sources

We will want to ask committee members to think of individuals who might make sense either as candidates or as people who would be good sources of information/referral of potential candidates. We are also interested in other schools/organizations you admire and would want us to explore.
