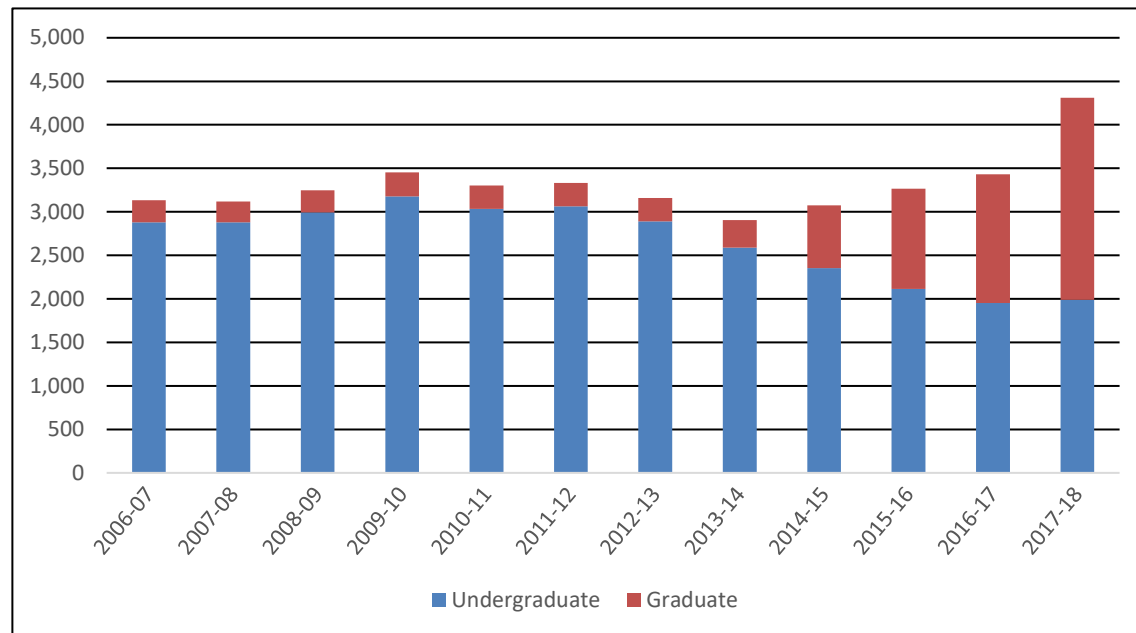

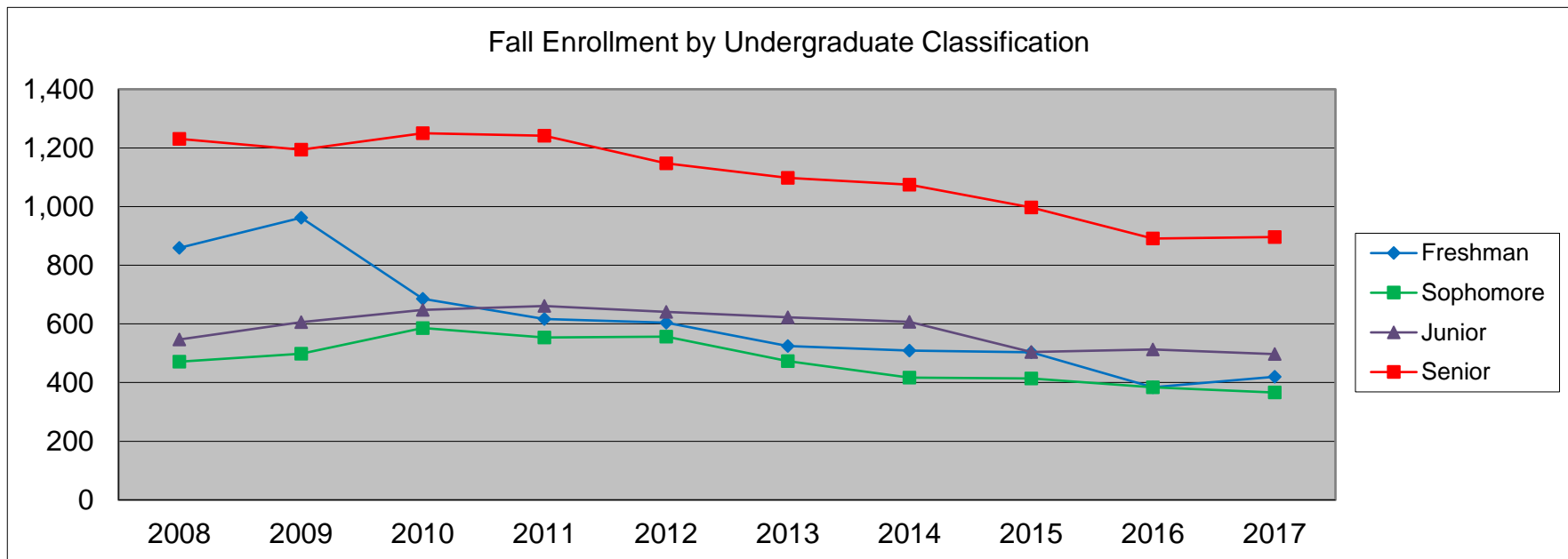

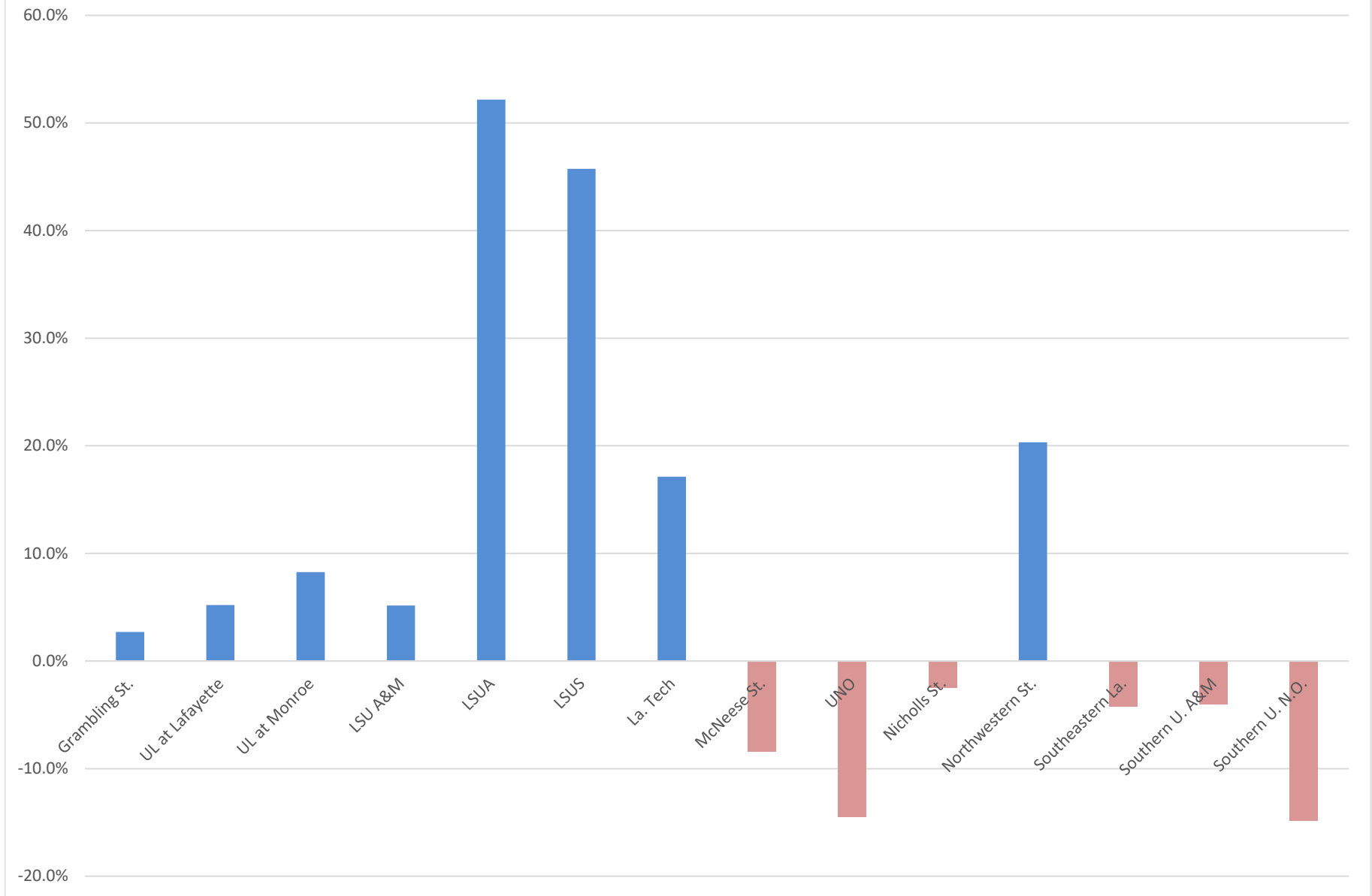
LSU System Institutions, Historical Enrollment

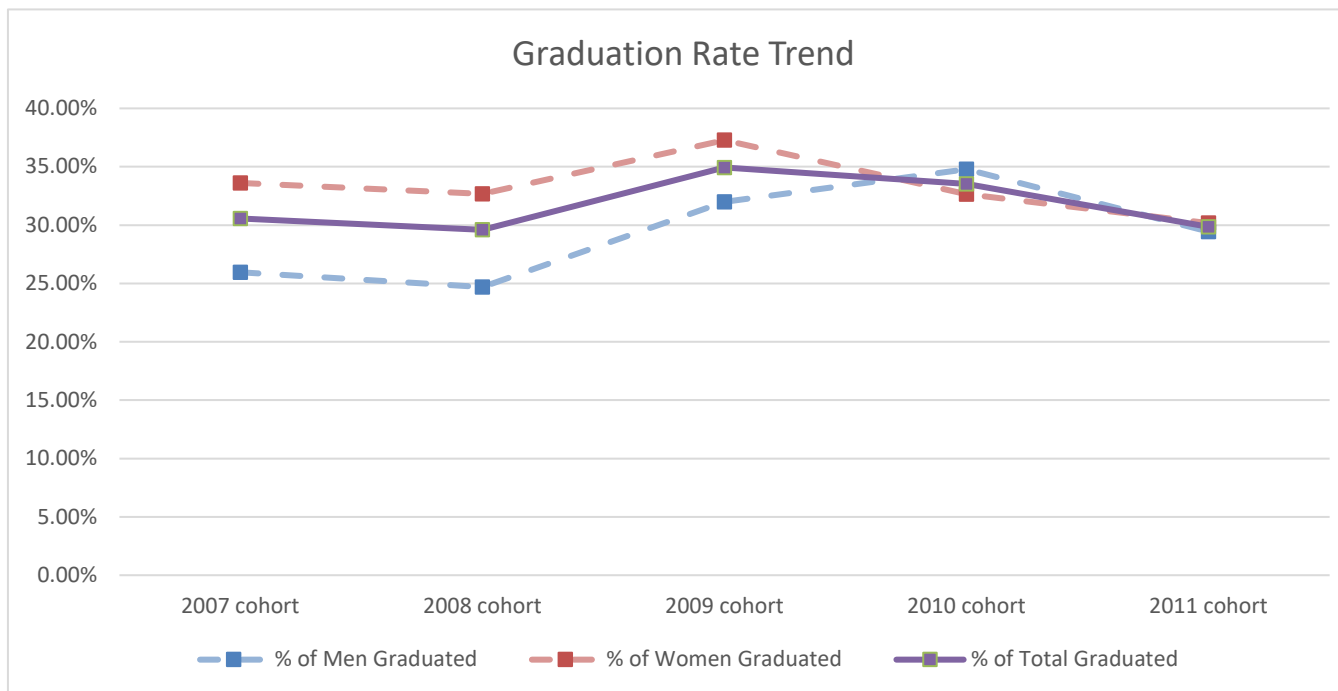

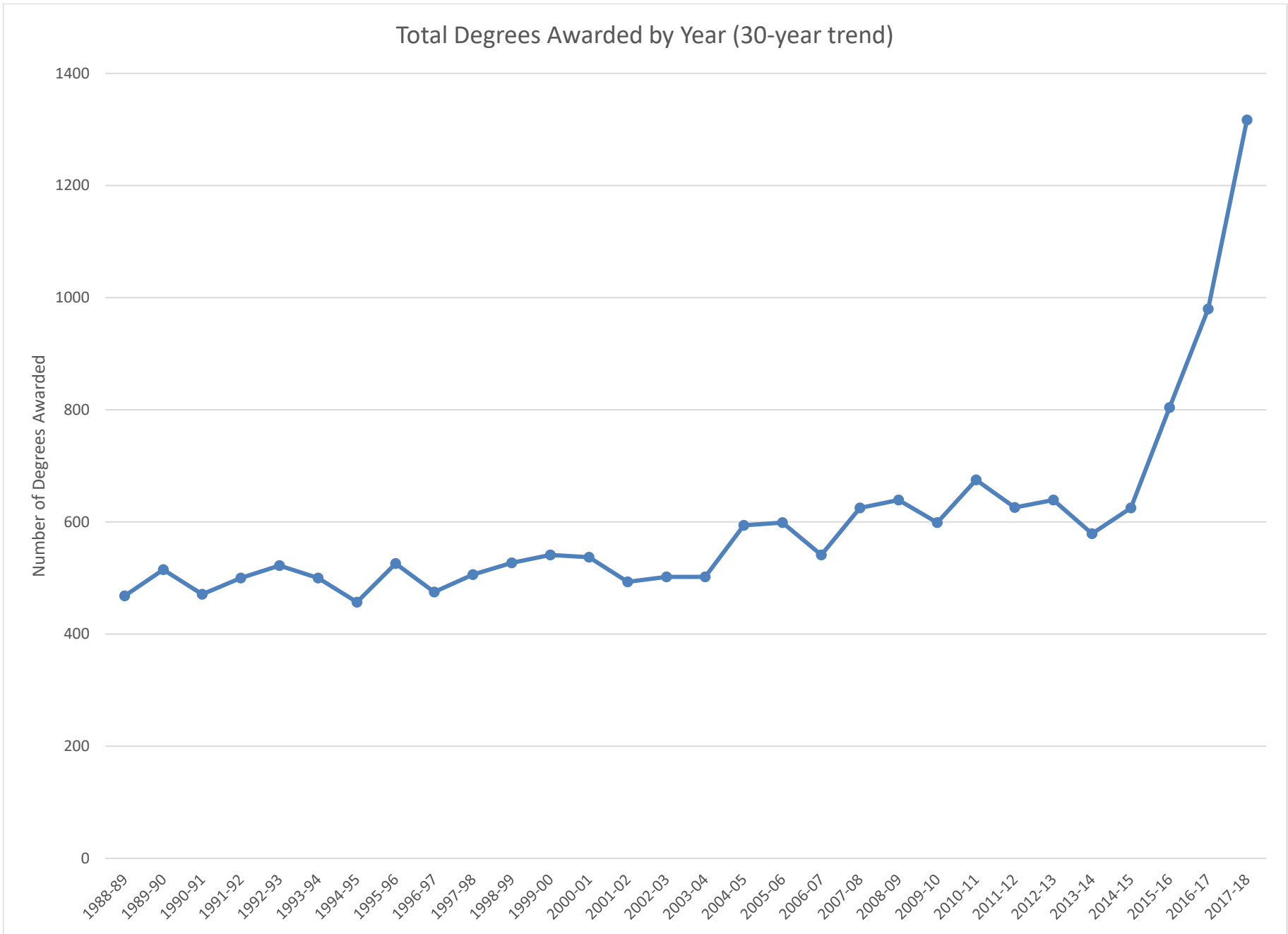
