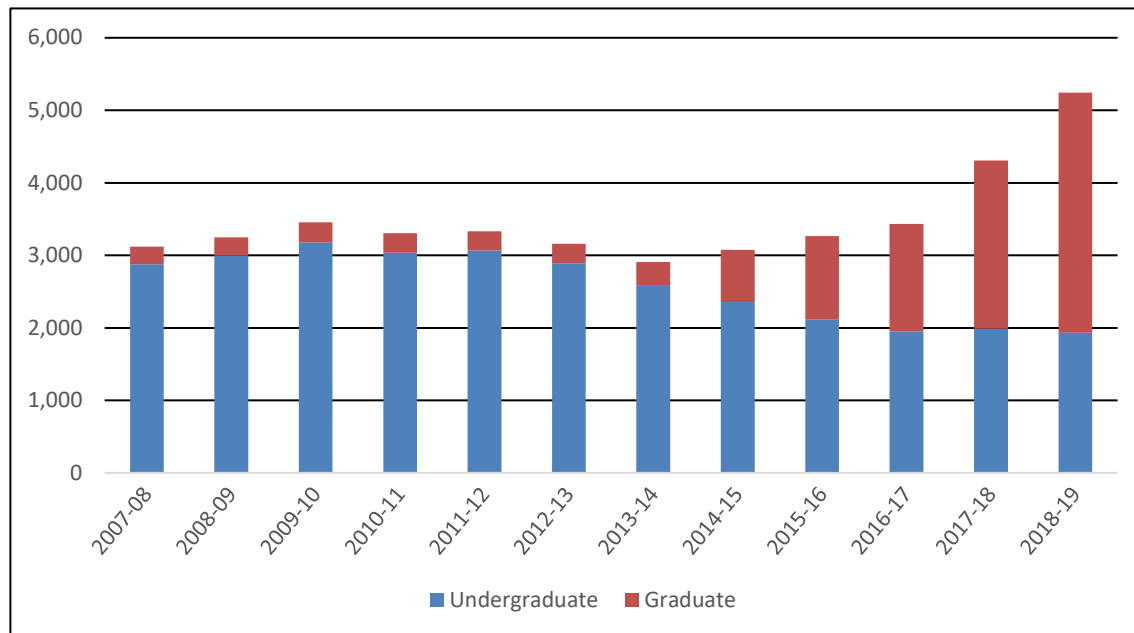

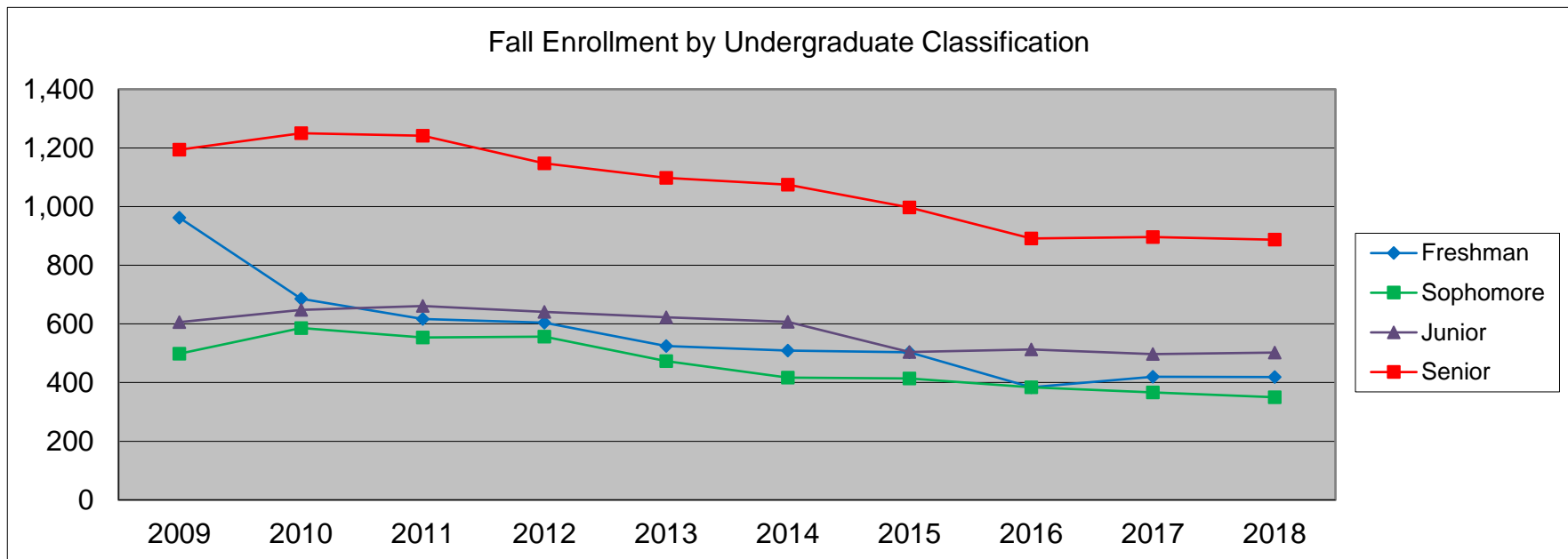

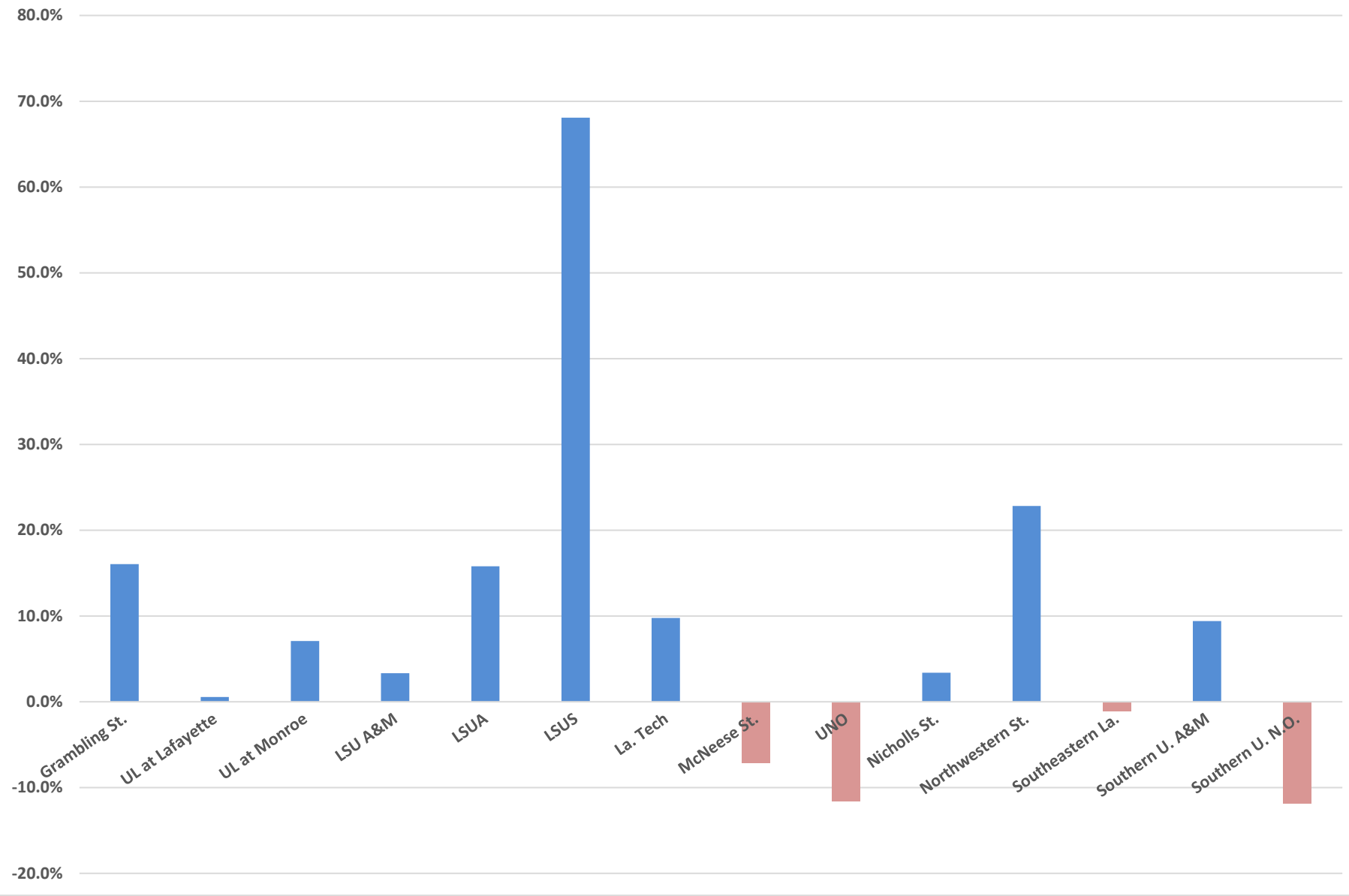
LSU System Institutions, Historical Enrollment

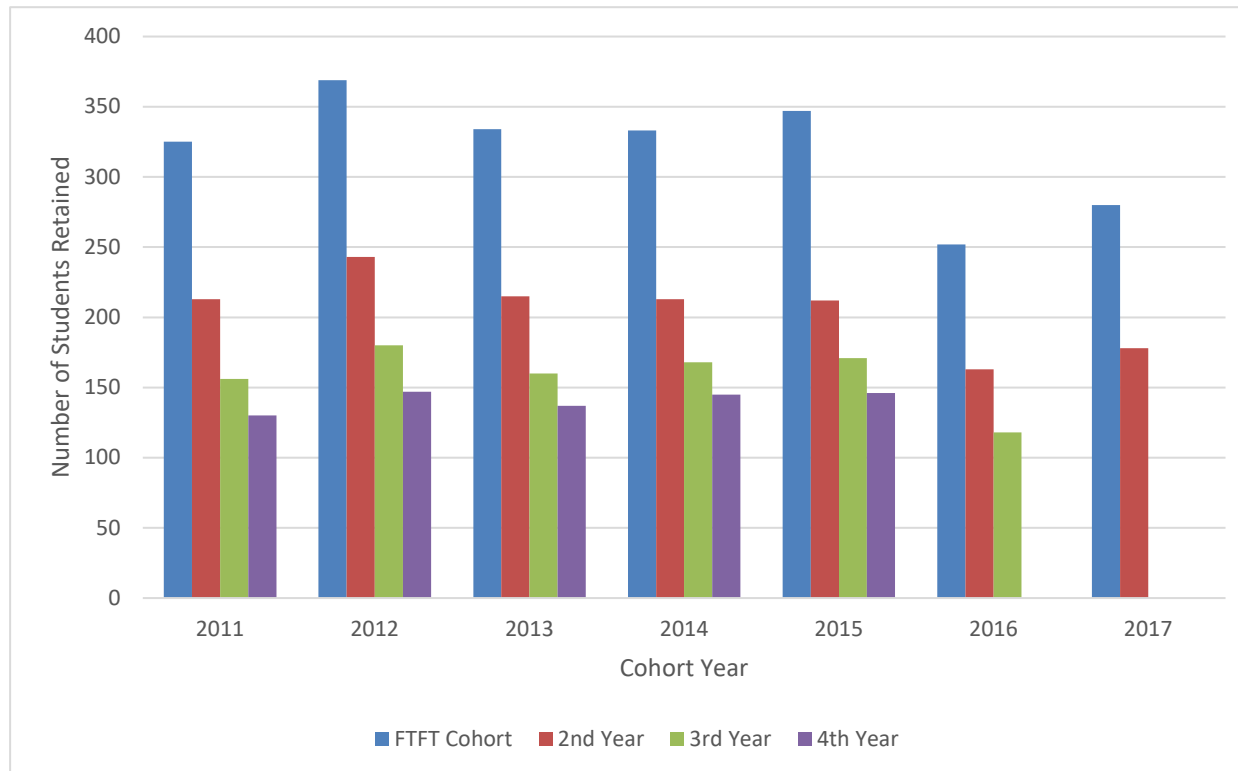
Louisiana Public Senior Institutions Percentage Change in Enrollment, 2014-18

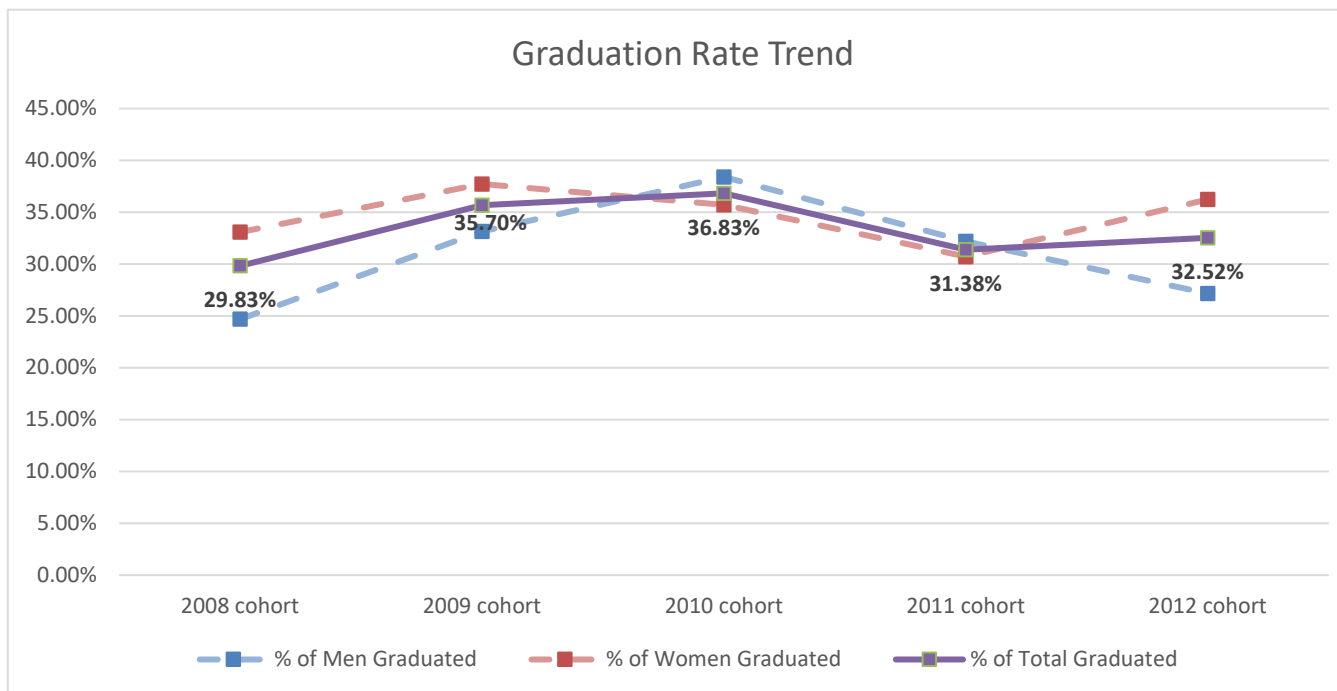

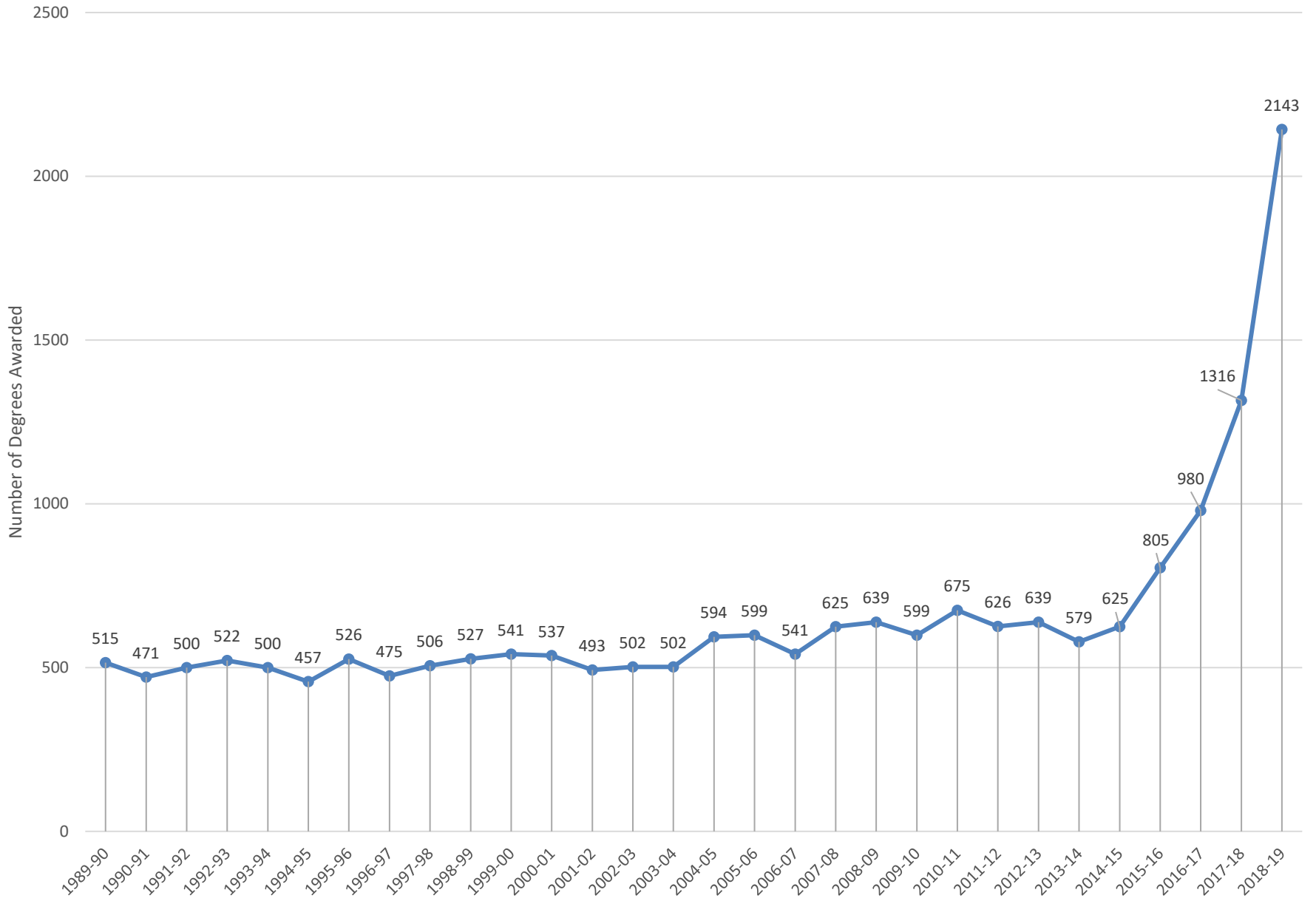
