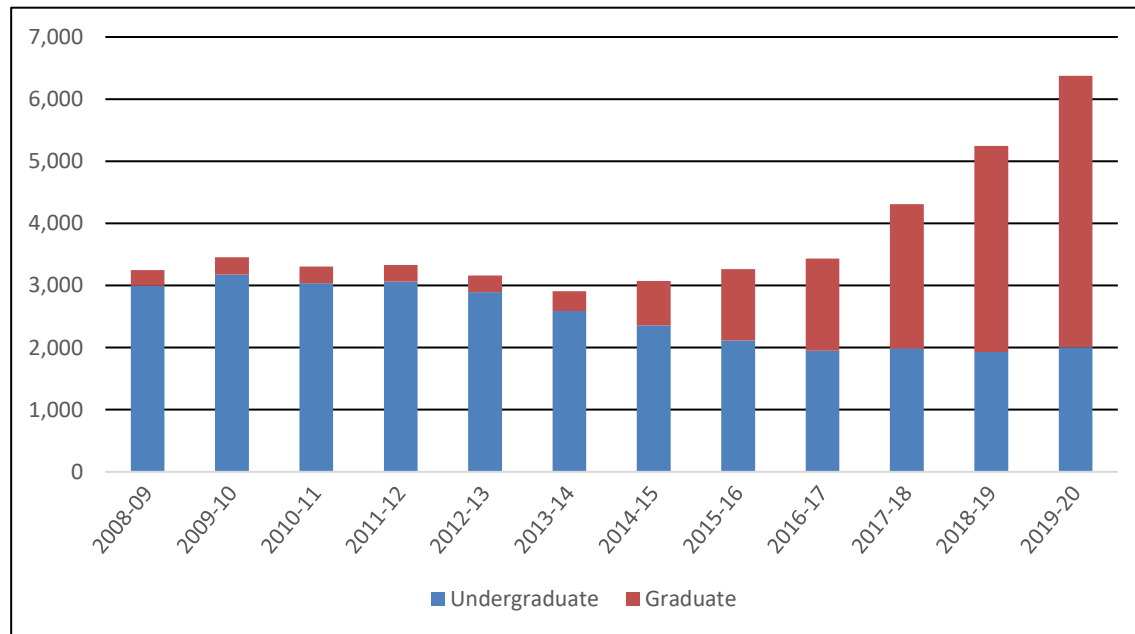

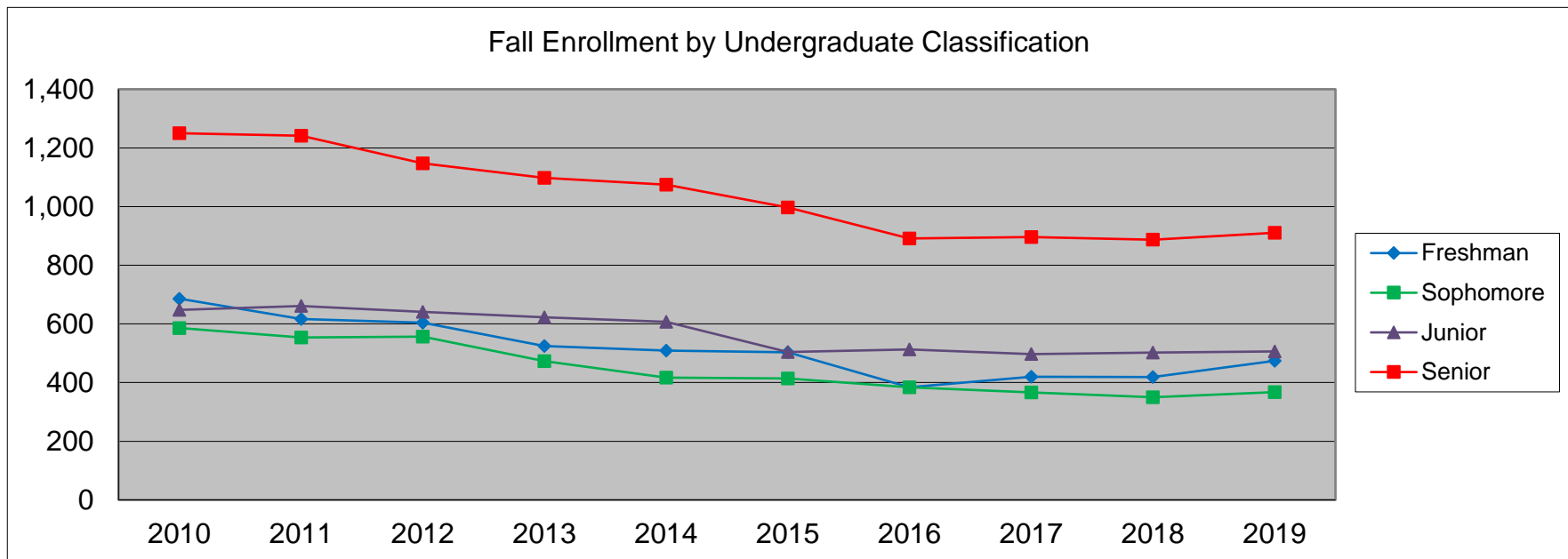

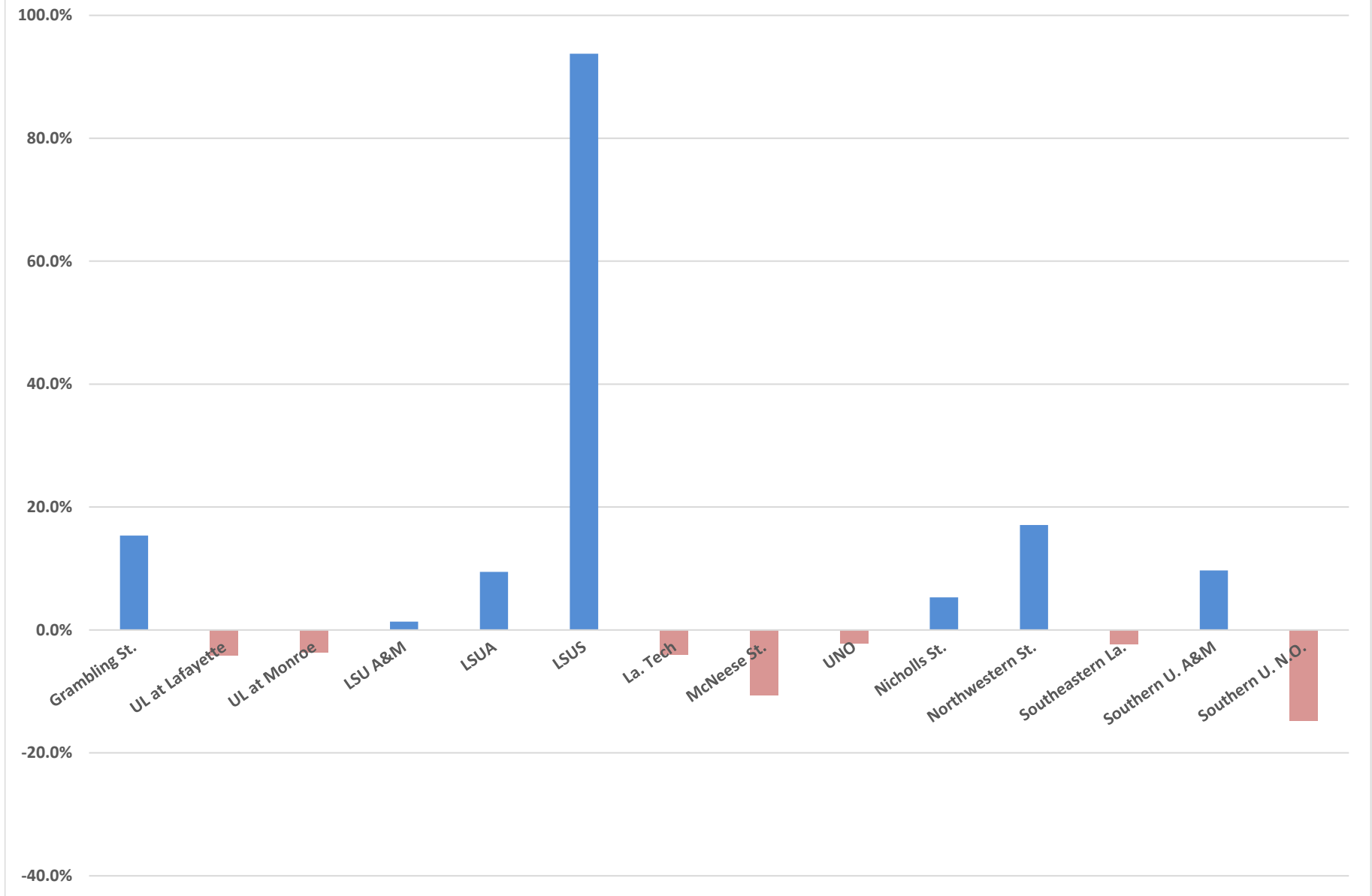
LSU System Institutions, Historical Enrollment



Louisiana Public Senior Institutions, Comparative Fall Enrollments

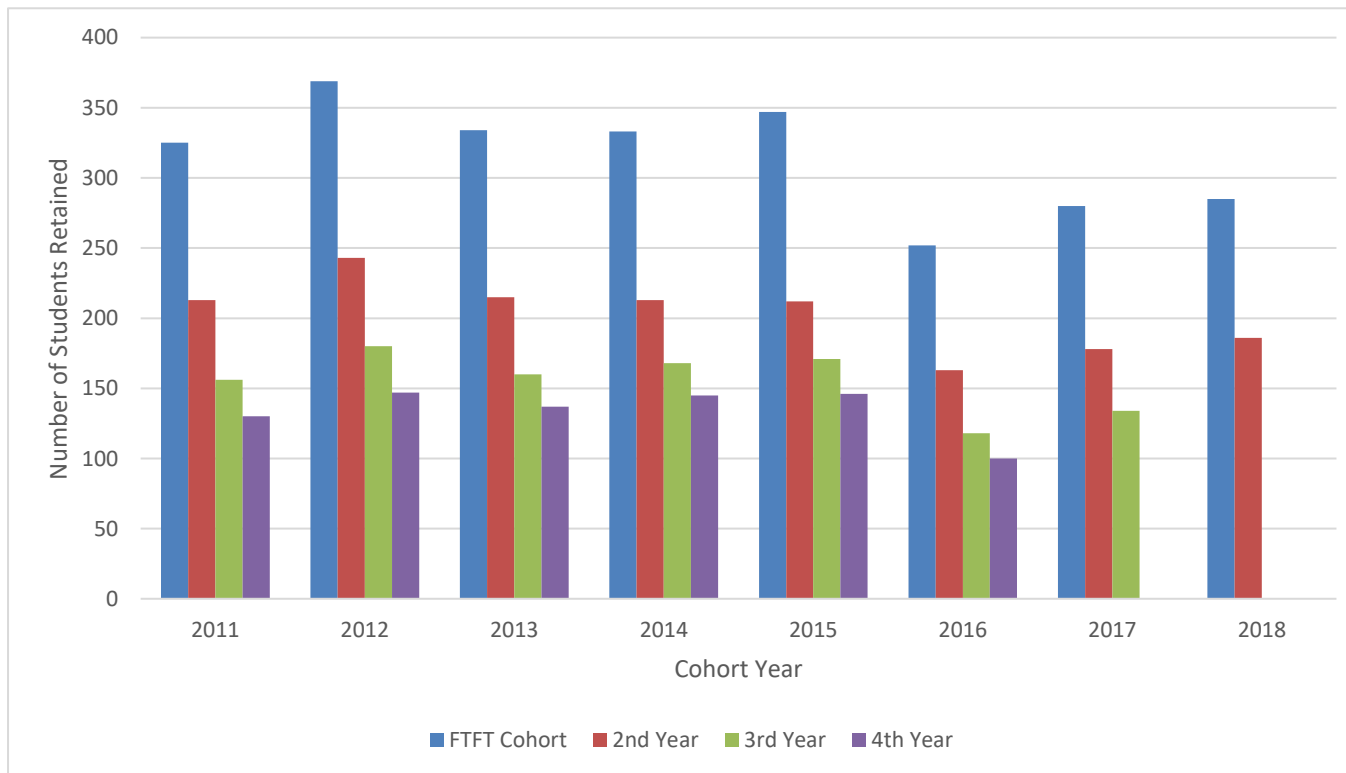

Louisiana Public Senior Institutions Percentage Change in Enrollment, 2015-19



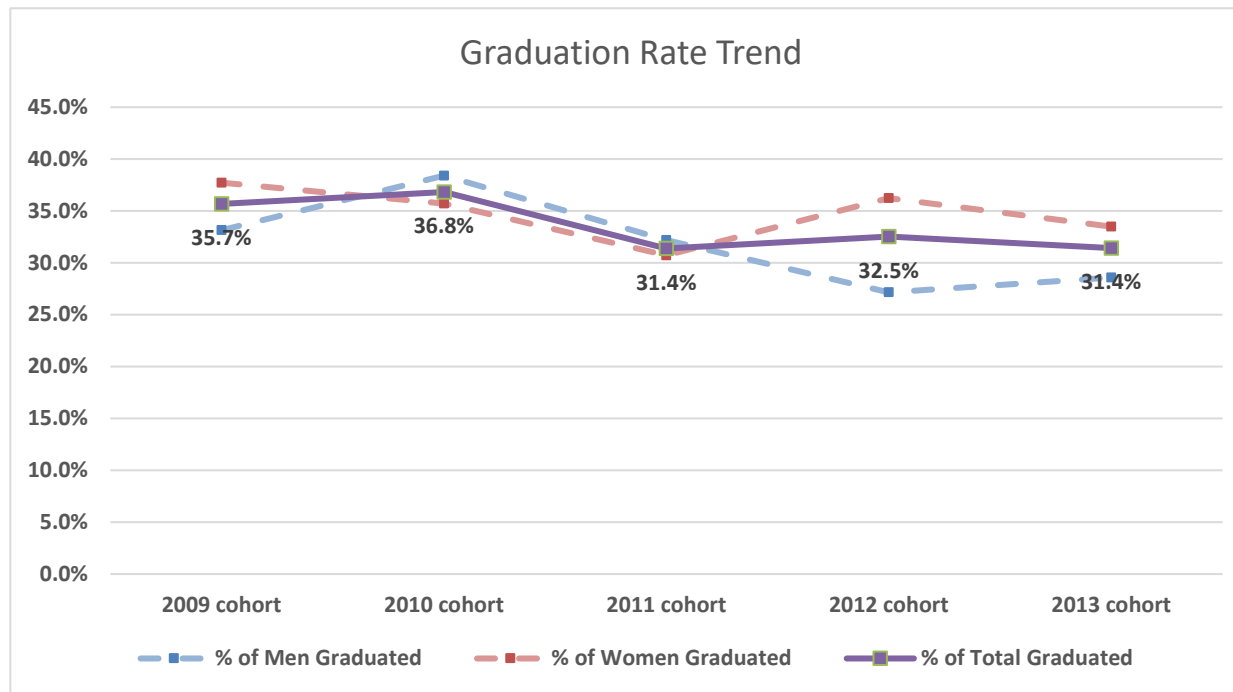

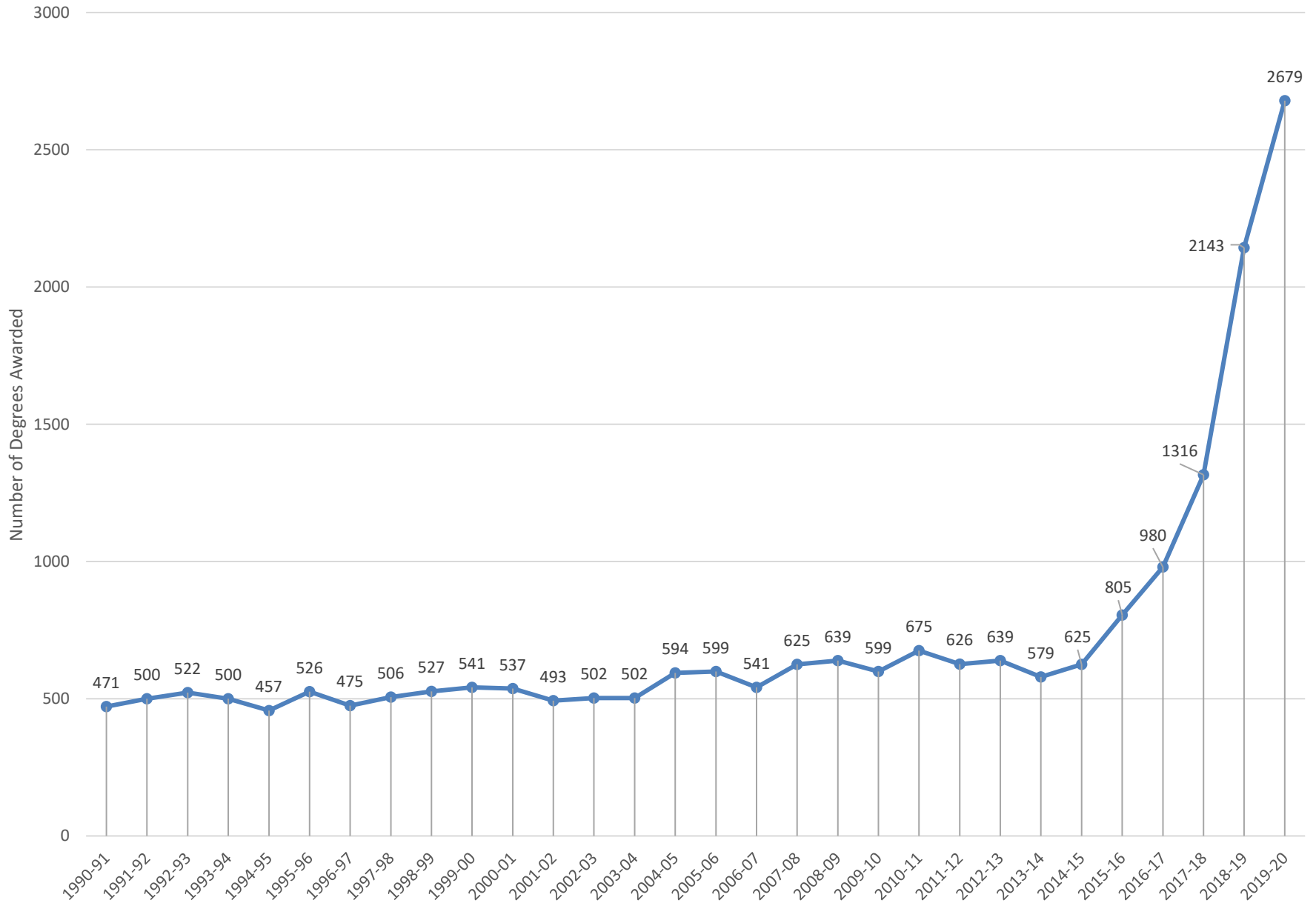
