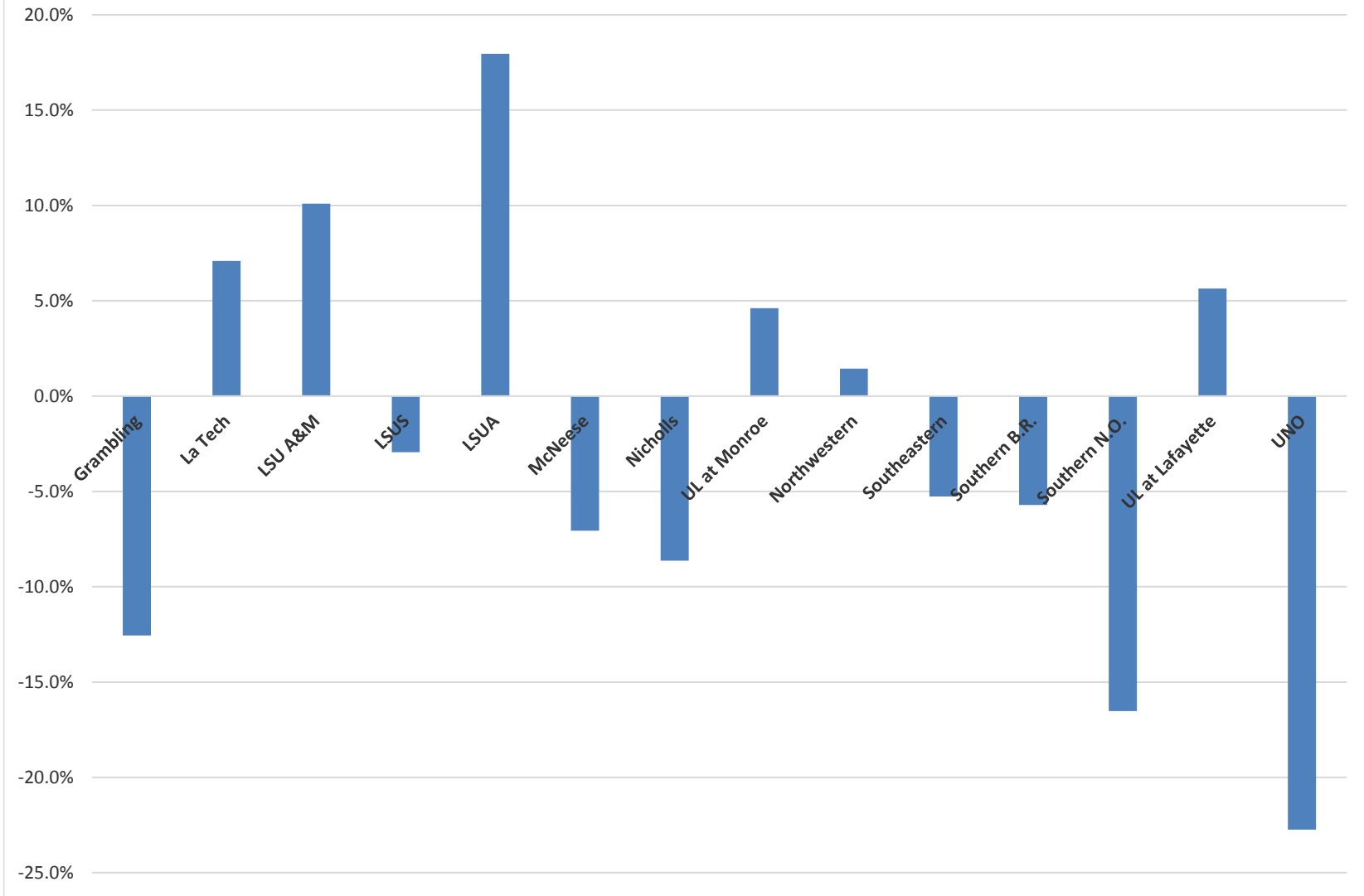
## Enrollment in LSU System Schools 2008-2015

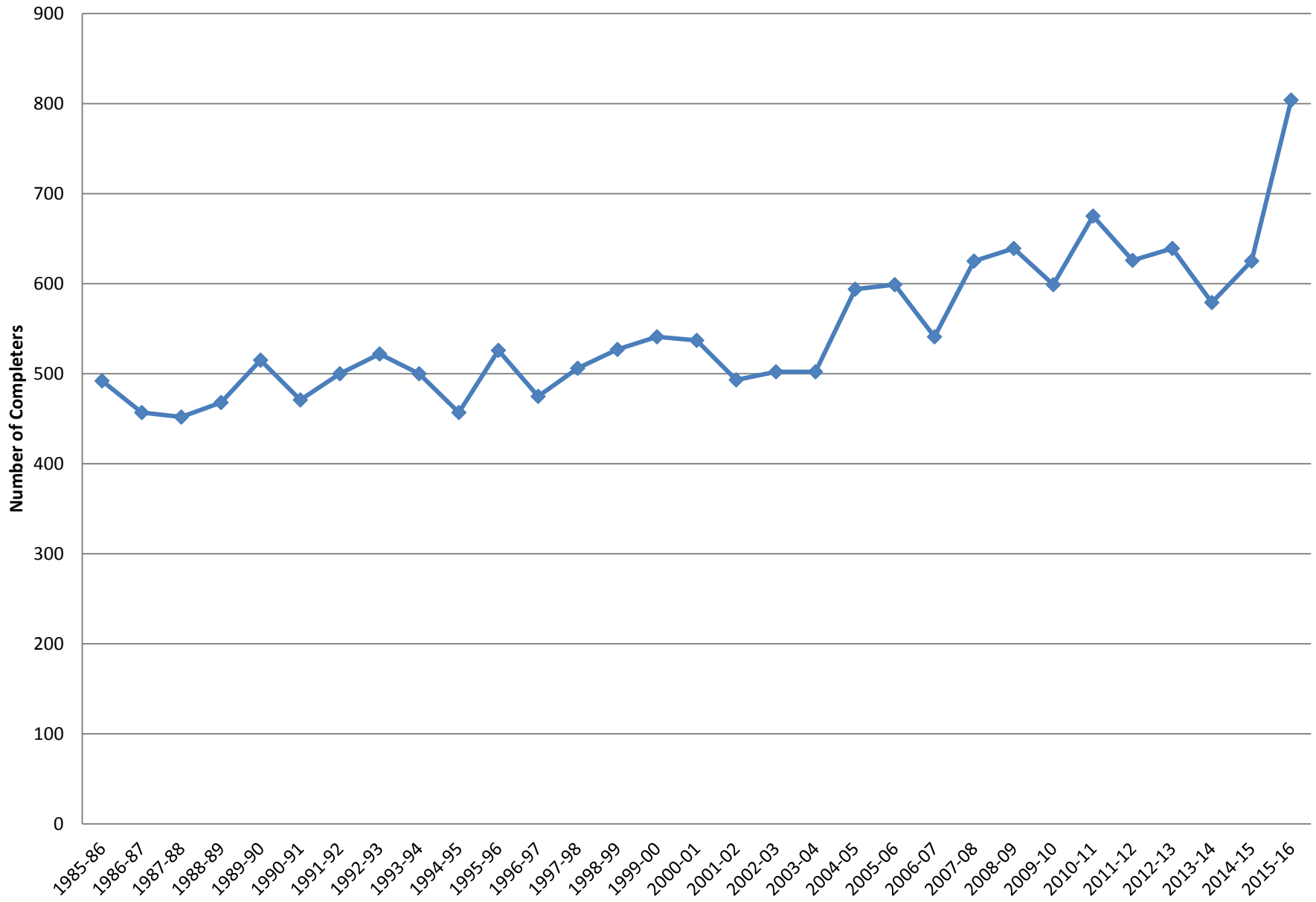
