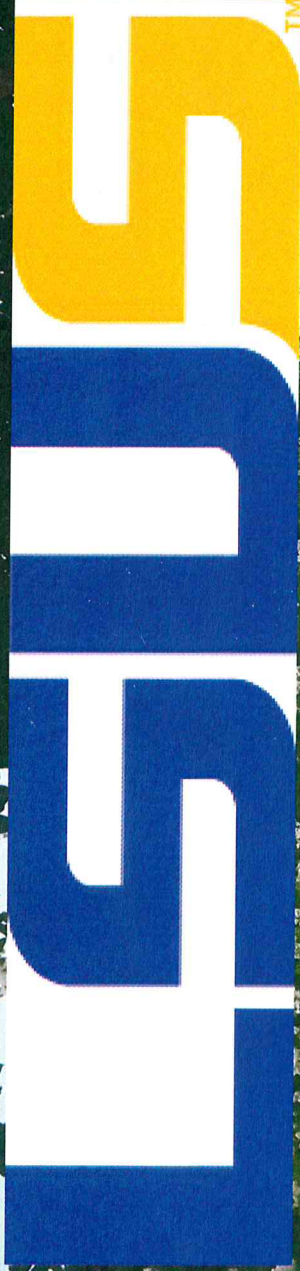
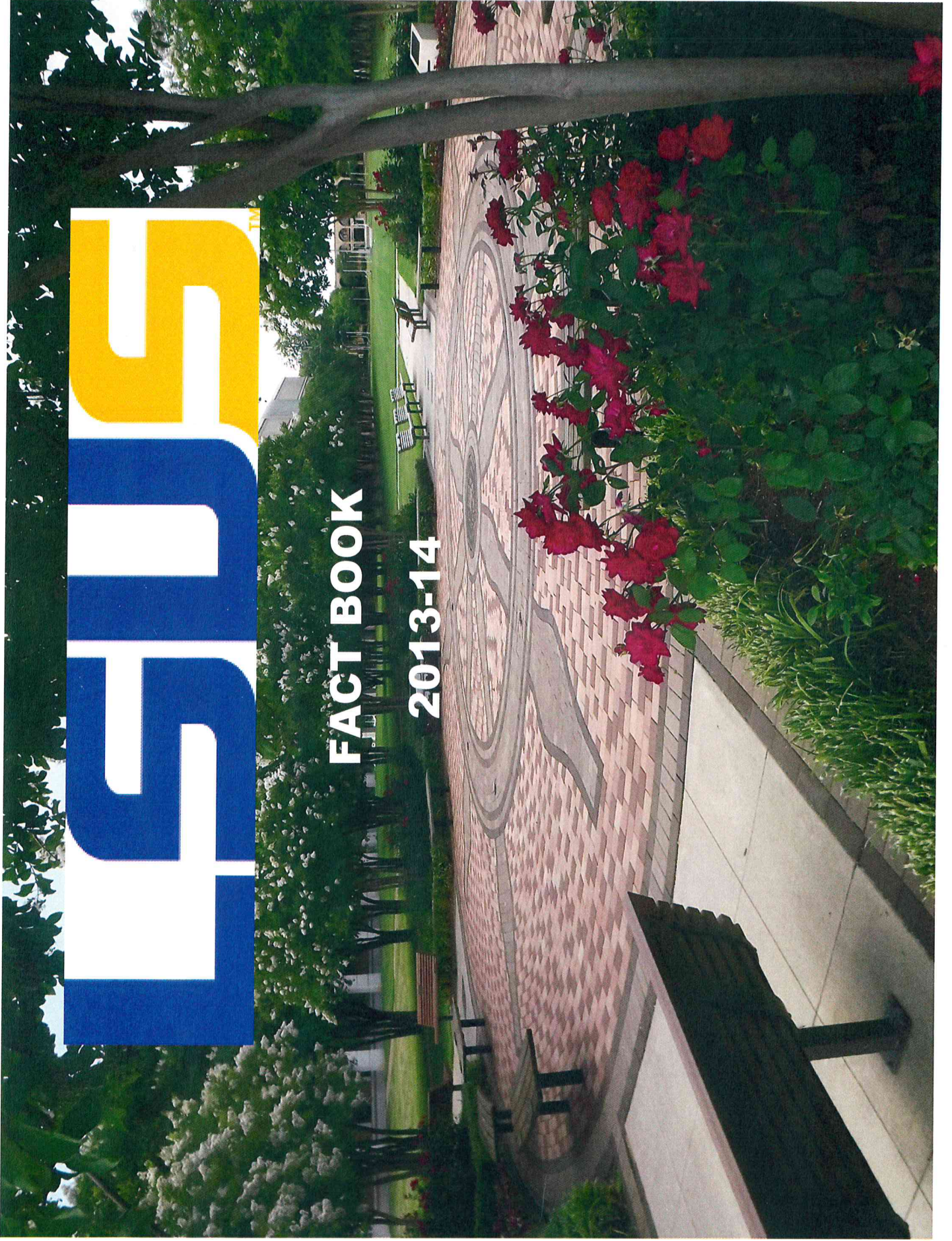

Executive Summary

The switch to a Fact Book instead of the traditional Data Profiles was implemented in 2012 for several reasons: to bring LSU Shreveport into alignment with other institutions' publications, to provide useful and meaningful data to all campus constituents, and to provide the information in a simple presentation that was easy to understand by all. Documented below are some of the important trends recognized from this data.

Enrollment Trends at LSUS

Fall 2013 saw a drop in overall enrollment at LSUS from 4535 in Fall 2012 to 4114 in Fall 2013. Decreases were found in the number of first-time freshmen, the number of continuing students, and the number of dual enrollment students. The number of graduate students rose slightly over the previous year and is consistent with the historical graduate numbers for the past 5 years of approximately 400 students. The majority of students enrolling at LSUS are from the Shreveport Bossier Metropolitan area (approximately 80%) which is consistent with the historical data from the past 10 years. One quarter of the undergraduate population is considered non-traditional (over 25 years in age), and the diversity of the student population has remained consistent approximately 63% White, 20% Black, and 17% other minority or unknown. In looking at enrollment trends over the past 10 years, the number of students at the freshman level has decreased 80% and retention of continuing students has decreased from approximately 70% to 58%. Additionally, 10 years ago LSUS enrolled 40% of all students attending one of the three public institutions in the Shreveport Bossier Metropolitan area, as of fall 2013 it had 25% of the market share.

Enrollment Trends by School and Program

Of the 25 undergraduate degree programs offered at LSUS Biological Sciences and Psychology programs are the most popular; however, three programs, Community Health, Fine Arts, and Computer Science, have grown in enrollment over the past three years. At the Graduate level a new degree program, Biological Sciences was added in 2012 and had an initial enrollment of 13 students and increased that number to 30 by the Fall 2013. Growth was also seen in the online Curriculum & Instruction, M.Ed., program which saw a record number of students, 61, enroll in the fall semester.

Enrollment Trends within the State and LSU System

Enrollment at the State's 4-year institutions has been relatively stagnant or negative since 2010 with only LSU Baton Rouge seeing an increase in enrollment. Within the LSU System, LSU Baton Rouge and the Health Science Centers saw an increase in enrollment in 2013 over the previous year.

Student Performance Profiles

Graduation rates of First-Time, Full-Time students at LSUS have increased significantly over the past four years. The 2007 cohort (latest available data) have set the highest graduation rate, 30.6%, in the history of LSUS. The graduation rate has been over 30 percent for the previous two years which shows a marked improvement over the past five years when the graduation rate hovered around 20 percent. The number of completers at the graduate level also shows steady increases to an all-time high of 127 during the 2013-14 academic year. LSUS has graduated over 19,000 students since the first graduating class.

Personnel Profiles

Over the past five years, the number of faculty at LSUS has decreased 11% and the number of total employees has decreased by 14%. The percentage of faculty members with tenure has increased over the past five years from 60% to 73%, and the percent of faculty with a terminal degree has remained around 80%.

2008-13

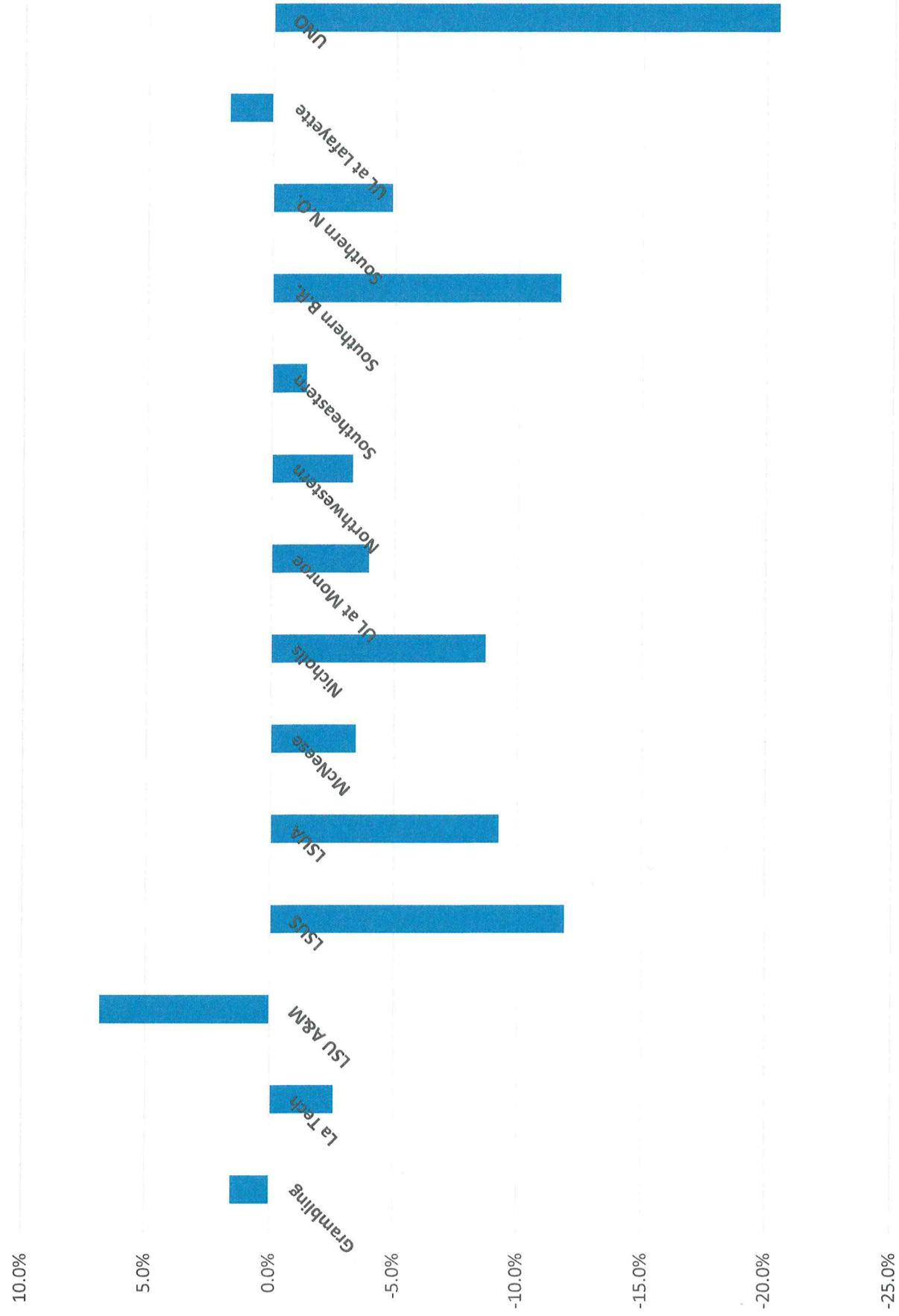

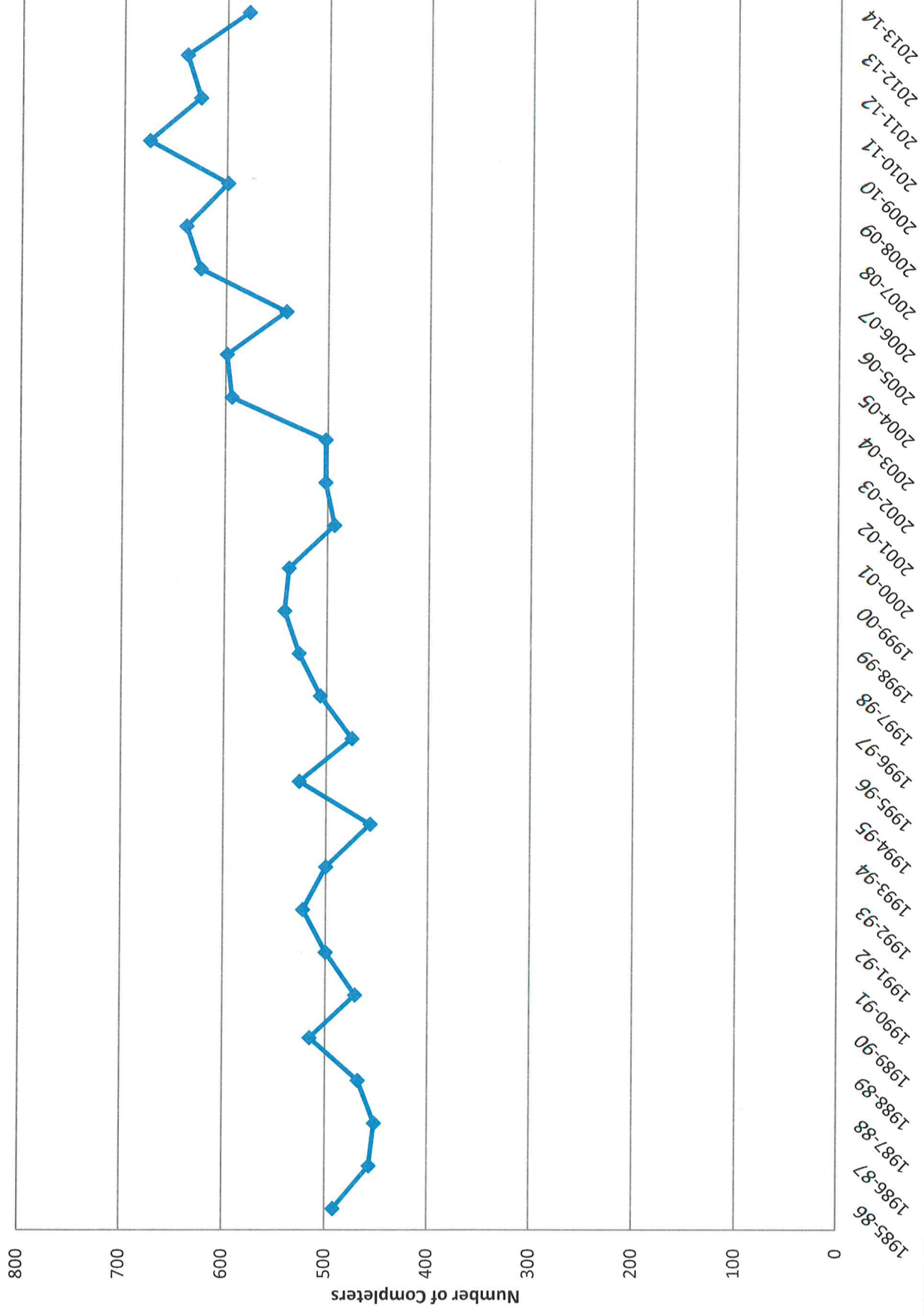
