Below is a to-do list that will help you in the process:

- 1. Complete and pay \$20 to process the LSUS PN application. This is available in our office, LSUS Technology Center-Room 141.
- Type a one-page essay explaining why you are interested in the program AND the profession. Font size should be 12, style-Times New Roman. Double-spaced with 1-inch margins. Be sure to include your name on the essay. Essays may be mailed or delivered to our office.

Please proof essay before turning it in, as this is part of the application process.

- 3. The following documents are required:
 - Driver's License/ Photo Identification Card
 - Official/ (Certified) Birth Certificate or passport with raised seal (we will copy)
 - Official/ (Certified) high school transcripts/GED
 - Official/ (Certified) transcripts from any colleges, universities or technical schools
 - GPA-2.5 on high school or college transcript
 - Official/ (Certified) scores on standardized testing (ACCUPLACER, ACCUPLACER NEXT GEN, TABE, ACT); these scores should not be older than <u>3 years</u>
